Lat = S. 13.50 These 24 houses strong breeze from S.E.
 Long = W. with cloudy weather the Bark steering
 35.35 by the wind on the Starboard tack heading
 about E.N.E. saw Spermuses during the

Lat = S. 12.30 These 24 houses very strong breeze from
 Long = W. about S.E. with cloudy weather the
 1.51 Bark steering by the wind on the
 Starboard tack heading about East

Monday Mar 8th

These 24 houses very strong breeze
 from S.E. with squalls of rain and
 cloudy weather the Bark steering by the
 wind on the Starboard tack heading
 about East

Tuesday Mar 9th

Lat = S. 10.56 These 24 houses very strong breeze from about
 Long = E. S.E. with light squalls of rain the Bark
 00.18 steering by the wind on the Starboard tack
 heading East the most of the time

Wednesday Mar 10th

Lat = S. 10.25 These 24 houses very strong breeze from about
 Long = E. S. the Bark steering by the wind on the
 1.46 Starboard tack heading East
 1.36

Thursday Mar 11th

Lat = S. 10.05 These 24 houses from breeze from about
 Long = E. S.E. with cloudy weather the Bark
 3.09 steering by the wind on the Starboard
 tack heading about E.S.E.

Lat = S. 10.00 These 24 houses light breeze from S.E.
 Long = E. the Bark steering by the wind on the
 4.23 Starboard tack. Took out some few small stores

 Two Boatsteers sick and off duty James Brown
 and John Samuels

Saturday Mar 13th

Lat = S. 10.10 These 24 houses light breeze from about
 Long = E. S.E. the Bark steering by the wind
 4.57 on the Port tack the most of the 24
 houses. The two Boatsteers still off duty

Sunday Mar 14th

Lat = S. 10.30 These 24 houses light breeze from
 Long = E. S.E. with a light shower of rain the Bark
 4.24 steering by the wind saw a Finback and
 a School of Agassiz Blackfish John Samuels
 returned to duty

Monday Mar 15th

Lat = S. 10.00 These 24 houses light breeze from S.E.
 Long = E. with fine weather the Bark steering by the
 5.37 wind on the Starboard tack until 3.30.
 P.M. then put her on the Port tack and
 Finbacks and Spermuses during the day
 employed in getting out clams for the
 Starboard bow Boat. James Brown still
 off duty

Tuesday Mar 16

Lat = S. 10.14 These 24 houses light breeze and
 Long = E. cloudy weather with S.E. the Bark
 5.46 steering by the wind on the Starboard
 tack after 5 A.M. James Brown
 still off duty. finished getting
 out the clams and beavers
 for Starboard bow Boat
