Humpbacking

Monday June 13<sup>th</sup> 1882

These 24 boats light breeze and calm with fine weather at 6 A.M. lowered three Boats and cruised saw nothing Boats got on board at sunset. took Knight Woodley out of wine at daylight and put them on again at night

Tuesday June 14<sup>th</sup>

These 24 boats fresh breeze and fine weather at daylight lowered two Boats and cruised saw the Kaituma Boats chasing two Whales at 2.30. A.M. the Capt. took the Waite Boat and went on board of Bark Greyhound of New Bedford Capt. Allen which is going about 15 miles to the seaward the two Boats got on board at sunset at night put Woodley in wine

Wednesday June 15<sup>th</sup>

This day fresh breeze at daylight lowered two Boats and cruised saw nothing got on board at 5 P.M. Capt. came on board at the same time at night put Woodley in wine

Friday June 16<sup>th</sup>

This day light breeze and calm lowered three Boats at daylight and cruised saw three Whales during the day chased one about 3 P.M. the Waite Boat struck hold on to him until 5.30. and the line parted Boats got on board at 2.45 P.M. took the rig off of Woodley this morning

Saturday June 17<sup>th</sup>

This day light fair and calm at daylight lowered three Boats saw one Whale got on board 6.30 P.M. Capt. Allen came on board from Bark Greyhound and stayed all night

Sunday June 18<sup>th</sup> 1882

These 24 boats fine weather did not lower for Whales Capt. Allen of Bark Greyhound left and went on board this boat and Boats crew came on board and stayed all night

Monday June 19<sup>th</sup>

This day light air and calm at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw five Whales did not get on to them Boats got on board about sunset

Tuesday June 20<sup>th</sup>

This day light air and calm at daylight lowered three Boats saw nothing Boats got on board about sunset

Wednesday June 21<sup>st</sup>

This day light breeze and fine weather at daylight lowered three Boats saw nothing of any Whales Boats got on board at sunset the Bark Kaituma anchored about one mile distance from us gamest with her in the evening heard several Whales during the night

Thursday June 22<sup>nd</sup>

This day fresh breeze at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw two Whales about 11.30. A.M. the Board Boat struck at 3 P.M. got him alongside of the ship and got dinner after dinner cut him in and cut the meat of the blubber into loaves and got supper at 6 P.M.
