

Journal of Bark *Wattapaisett*Humphreys
Monday July 3rd 1882

This day fresh and slight breeze with fine weather about 7.30 A.M. have up anchor and steered in shore at about 10. A.M. anchored in 4 fathoms of water and paid out 30 fathoms of cable at about 1.30 P.M. Capt. went on shore and got about 10 bushels of Potatoes and 30 bunches of Bananas and 1500 oranges at about 3.30. have up anchor and steered to the Northward down the coast repaired the barboard Boat during the day James Parker came on board drunk after going ashore in the Capt. Boat.

Tuesday July 4th

This day light breeze and cloudy weather the Bark steering Northward down the coast stowed down the oil from the two Whales 5 & 2 gallons and coals at off decks.

Wednesday July 5th

This day light breeze at daylight lowered three Boats saw two Whales about 9 A.M. Whaler Boat struck at about 11.30 A.M. in sea down and lost the Whale about 4 P.M. the Bark Anchored in 21 fathoms of water with 40 fathoms of cable Boats set on board at about 4.30 P.M. saw in Bark at Anchor to the seaward so ends this day.

Thursday July 6th

This day light air and calm at daylight lowered three Boats saw three four Whales got none Boats got on board at sunset put the barboard and Bow Boats back on their cranes again.

Friday July 7th 1882

This day light air and calm at daylight lowered three Boats saw four Whales got none Boats got on board at 5 P.M.

Saturday July 8th

This day light air and calm at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised sail four Whales but got none Boats got on board at 6 P.M. so ends this day.

Sunday July 9th

This day light air at 6.30 A.M. have up anchor and made sail and steered the Bark to the Northward down the coast saw a Bark to the seaward about 4 P.M. saw two Whales lowered two Boats but could not get on at about 5.30 P.M. Anchored in 18 fathoms of water with 30 fathoms of cable gained the Bark overhauled in the evening so ends this day.

Monday July 10th

This day light breeze at daylight lowered two Boats and cruised saw 12 Whales the barboard Boat had a Whale missed by the Boatowner Antine Ganselver about 9 A.M. the Capt. went on shore with a boat and got two men the Boats got on board at about 6 P.M. so ends the two men are called Jimbo and Sambo.

Tuesday July 11th

This day light breeze and fine weather at daylight have up anchor and steered the Bark down the coast lowered three Boats saw four or five Whales paid saw to sails one over the overhauled at 2 P.M. anchored the Bark in 19 fathoms of water with 40 fathoms of chain off Anata's point Boats got on board at 6 P.M.
