HumphreysSaturday August 12th

This day light breeze at 6 A.M. called all hands and got breakfast and then began to cut the whale. Cut him in byot cut the blubber into basepieces and broke out in the main hatch ready to stow oil during the day. saw one whale from the ship but did not lower the Boats so ends

Sunday August 13th

This day fresh breeze and cloudy 6.30 A.M. lowered two Boats saw the whale from the Boats and 4 or 5 from the ship. The Starboard Boats crew and shipkeepers employed in boiling and stowing down. The Boats got on board 5.30 P.M.

Monday August 14th

This day light breeze and cloudy about 7 A.M. lowered two Boats saw five or six whales. finished boiling about 10.30 A.M. stowed down some oil during the day. Boats got on board about 5.30 P.M.

Tuesday August 15th

This day light breeze from N.W. at daylight lowered two Boats saw two whales saw Back Kattken. she Anchored close by at sunset. stowed some oil during the day. Boats got on board at 5.45 P.M.

Wednesday August 16th

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered three Boats saw two whales. The Back Kattken sailed Northward. Boats got on board 5.30 P.M.

Thursday August 17th 1852

This day light breeze and cloudy at daylight lowered three Boats saw four whales saw the Back Kattken Boats chasing two whales about 2 P.M. they gave them up and then we chased with our boats about 3 P.M. Starboard Boat struck killed him and got him to the ship about 8.45 P.M. the Back got underway to take the whale and Anchored again after got the whale alongside

Friday August 18th

This day light breeze at 3.30 A.M. the Shark began to eat the whale. so called all hands and began to cut in finished and got breakfast about 7 A.M. about 9 A.M. lowered two Boats saw one whale Boats got on board 4.30 P.M. and hove up anchor and stowed the Back in shore at 5.30. Anchored again so ends

Saturday August 19th

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered two Boats about 7 A.M. began to boil saw no whales Boats got on board at 6 P.M. so ends

Sunday August 20th

This day light air and calm at 6.45 A.M. lowered two Boats saw no whales finished boiling at about 7.50 A.M. Boats got on board at about 6 P.M.

Monday August 21st

This day light breeze and calm lowered three Boats saw two whales Boats got on board about sunset so ends
