Lat. S. 4. 37 These 24 hours light air from S. W.
Long. E. the Bark steering by the wind on the
6. 02 Port tack heading about W. N. W.

Thursday Sept. 21st
Lat. S. 4. 33 These 24 hours light air from about
Long. E. the Port tack saw Porpoises and Algerines
5. 19 During the day broke out some Cirriform
fog the ship sent John A. Lyons out
of the Galley he now is in the forecabin as
a common seaman

Friday Sept. 22nd
Lat. S. 4. 34 These 24 hours light breeze and fine
Long. E. weather wind about S. S. W. the Bark
steering by the wind on the Port tack
4. 24 heading about W. this day put
Charles Wade in the Galley to cook the
remainder of this cruise

Saturday Sept. 23rd
Lat. S. 4. 30 These 24 hours light breeze and
Long. E. fine weather wind from S. W. the
Bark steering by the wind on the
3. 15 Port tack until about 4. 30 P. M. put
the Bark on the Starboard tack and
steered by the wind heading S. by E. & E
saw Grampuses during the day

Sunday Sept. 24th
Lat. S. 4. 40 These 24 hours fine weather with light
Long. E. breeze from S. S. W. the Bark steering by
the wind on the Port tack heading
3. 00 the onset of the time about West
saw Grampuses and Porpoises during
the day Saw a Comet about 4. A. M.
beginning about E. and about 20.00. above
the horizon

Monday Sept. 25th 1882
No Obs. These 24 hours light breeze and cloudy
wind about S. S. W. the Bark steering
by the wind on the Port tack heading
W. N. E.

Tuesday Sept. 26th
Lat. S. 5. 30 These 24 hours fresh breeze from S. S. W.
Long. E. and cloudy the Bark steering by the wind
on the Port tack until 6. P. M. then put
the Bark on the Starboard tack heading
S. E. saw Porpoises and Algerines

Wednesday Sept. 27th
Lat. S. 5. 43 These 24 hours fresh breeze from about
Long. E. S. S. W. the Bark steering by the wind
on the Port tack after 4. A. M. so ended
heading about S. W. by W. & W.

Thursday Sept. 28th
Lat. S. 6. 00 These 24 hours moderate breeze and cloudy
Long. E. weather the wind very unsteady from S. S. E.
to S. S. W. the Bark steering by the wind
tacked twice during the day at sunset
the Bark steering by the wind on the Port
tack heading S. W. by W.

Friday Sept. 29th
Lat. S. 6. 50 These 24 hours strong breeze from about
Long. W. S. by E. the Bark steering by the wind
on the Port tack until 4. 30 P. M. then
put the Bark on the Starboard tack and
steered by the wind heading E. by S.

Saturday Sept. 30th
Lat. S. 6. 54 These 24 hours fresh breeze and some
Long. E. light squalls of rain the Bark steering by the
wind on the Starboard tack until 3. P. M. then
tacked and steered by the wind on the Port
tack. Wind from S. Bark heading W. S. W.
