Expressing

Friday Dec 1st 1882

These 24 hours light breeze and cloudy the Bark steering N.W. under all sail. Painted the Starboard Boat during the day

Saturday Dec 2nd

Lat = S. These 24 hours light breeze from S.E.
8.52 the Bark steering N.W. under all sail
Long = E. saw a Finback and Porpoises. put
1.20 the new Boat on the Starboard cronee
the old one on the Bow cronee and
the old Starboard Boat on the house

Sunday Dec 3rd

Lat = S. These 24 hours light breeze and fine
8.49 weather the Bark steering N. under all
Long = E. sail saw a Finback and some Porpoises
0.7 during the day

Monday Dec 4th

Lat = These 24 hours light breeze and fine
9.21 S. weather the Bark steering N. under all
Long = W. sail Brake out some provisions during
1.42 the day

Tuesday Dec 5th

Lat = S. This day fresh breeze from S.E. the Bark
10.00 steering N. under all sail the watch
Long = W. employed making spruysam and
3.00 splined the main top gallant stay which
had parted

Wednesday Dec 6th

Lat = S. This 24 hours fresh breeze the Bark
10.48 steering N.W. I saw a Finback. Painted
Long = W. the Starboard Boat during the day
5.05

Thursday Dec 7th 1882

Lat = S. These 24 hours light breeze and fine
11.55 weather the Bark steering N. under all sail
Long = W. unbent the Fore sail and cut it up and
7.00 bent a new one the Capt. and
Charles Johnson sick and off duty
saw Porpoises so ends

Friday Dec 8th

Lat = S. These 24 hours light breeze from S.E.
12.00 the Bark steering N.W. under all
Long = W. sail. unbent the main sail and the
8.47 watch employed in repairing it
the Capt. well again on duty Charles Johnson
still off duty

Saturday Dec 9th

Lat = S. These 24 hours light breeze and fine
11.51 weather the Bark steering N.W. under
Long = W. all sail finished repairing the main sail
10.27 and bent it again the Capt. is back
up again Charles Johnson is the same
at sunset took in the light sails
hauled up the courses and huped to
the wind on the Starboard tack heading
E. N. E. so ends

Sunday Dec 10th

Lat = S. This day light breeze with fine weather
10.58 at daylight steered the Bark off N.W. W
Long = W. and made all sail at sunset took
11.00 in the light sails hauled up the
courses and huped to the wind on the
Starboard tack heading E. the Capt. still
sick Charles Johnson some better
so ends
