at LeandaMonday Oct 22nd 1883

This day first broke out some oil
and took on board 3180 stks of Wood
hired three men one man which has
shipped here came on board at duty
this day name Antoine Joseph

Tuesday Oct 23rd

This day light breeze and cloudy the
men employed at various jobs hired
four men

Wednesday Oct 24th

This day fine employed in discharging and
shipping Oil per Portuguese Brigantine Thersie of Lisbon
for New Bedford hired five men

Thursday Oct 25th

This day fine employed in discharging Oil
hired five men

Friday Oct 26th

This day fine employed in shipping oil
hired four men finished discharging
the oil

Saturday Oct 27th

This day fine weather the men employed
in stowing the bolts hired three men

Sunday Oct 28th

This day fine weather doing nothing

Monday Oct 29th

This day fine weather employed in stowing
the bolts ready for sea and taking water

New Bedford Capt A. L. Stickney
Beyond WestwardTuesday Oct 30th 1883

These 24 hours fresh breeze and pleasant
weather took some vegetables on board
and at 4.15 P.M. hove up anchor and
went to sea at sight the Bark steering
by the Wind on the Port tack shipped
a crew of thirteen men while logging
in Port and got them all on board
shipped Mr. Phillips crew for 2nd mate

This day light breeze and calm wind
unsteady from S.W. to N.W. the
Bark steering S.S.W. part of the time
under all sail for two men this day
which stowed away on board both
Portuguese from shore

Thursday Nov 1st

This 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
the Bark steering by the wind on
the Port tack saw a Humpback and
saw Porpoises

Friday Nov 2nd

Lat. S.
8.25
Long. E.
10.46

These 24 hours light breeze from about
W.S.W. the Bark steering by the Wind
on the Port tack saw Finbacks
and Blackfish

Saturday Nov 3rd

These 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
the Bark steering by the wind saw
Finbacks and Porpoises turned up
the starboard Boat and worked her ready
to paint & etc
