

Lat-S. 7. 25 Sunday Nov. 4th 1883
 Long-E. 9. 18 These 24 hours light breeze from S. S. W.
 to S. W. with fine weather. The Bark
 steering by the wind on the Port tack

Lat-S. 7. 50 Monday Nov. 5th
 Long-E. 8. 20 These 24 hours light breeze and fine
 weather. Painted the Starboard Boat during
 the forenoon about 10 A.M. raised a School
 of Sperm Whales. lowered the Starboard
 and Shearwater Boats at 12 noon at
 1 P.M. lowered the Whistle Boat. Starboard
 Bow Boat struck and killed two hae-
 ones. the Starboard Boat struck and killed
 one and got one that was lanced. Bow Boat
 got the other than got the Whales to the
 ship and made fast and got supper at 7 P.M.

Lat-S. 7. 40 Tuesday Nov. 6th
 Long-E. 8. 13 This day light breeze at 5 A.M. called
 all hands and got ready to cut. 6.30
 began to cut and finished and
 finished at noon 5 P.M. began to
 boil so ends boiling

Lat-S. 7. 46 Wednesday Nov. 7th
 Long-E. 8. 45 This day light air and calm. boiling at
 9.30. A.M. raised a School of Sperm Whales
 off the Weatherbeam at noon lowered the
 three Boats for them but did not get
 on they were galled by Blackfish
 Boats got on board at 7 P.M. got
 supper and began to boil again so ends

Lat-S. 8. 07 Thursday Nov. 8th
 Long-E. 9. 14 This day light breeze all hands employed in
 boiling. at 4.30 P.M. raised a School of Sperm
 Whales going quick. did not get near enough
 to make finished boiling about 10.30 P.M.

Friday, Nov. 9th 1883
 These 24 hours light breeze from S.W. at
 about 6 A.M. raised a School of Sperm Whale
 at 7.15. lowered three Boats at 9. L. Boat struck
 got him to the ship at noon and went
 off to chase the school again but did not
 get near then Boats got on board at 6 P.M.



Lat-S. 7. 42 Saturday Nov. 10th
 Long-E. 8. 42 This day light air. cut in the whale
 in the morning about 9 A.M. raised
 a School of Sperm Whales at 2.15 P.M.
 lowered the two quarter Boats at 5 P.M.
 L. Boat struck a large Whale but soon
 showed about 20 minutes after struck
 again a small Whale killed him and
 got him to the ship about 11 P.M. so ends

Lat-S. 7. 33 Sunday Nov. 11th
 Long-E. 8. 43 These 24 hours light breeze and fine weather
 cut the whale in the morning and began
 to boil so ends this day boiling

Lat-S. 7. 17 Monday Nov. 12th
 Long-E. 8. 46 This day light breeze from S.W. the crew
 employed in boiling and sewing down

Lat-S. 7. 38 Tuesday Nov. 13th
 Long-E. 8. 07 These 24 hours light breeze with fine
 weather the Bark steering by the wind on
 the Port tack struck down some
 oil during the day

Lat-S. 7. 32 Wednesday Nov. 14th
 Long-E. 7. 38 This day light breeze and fine weather
 the Bark steering by the wind on
 the Starboard tack shooting to the S.E.
 finished stowing down the oil
