 7.34 These 24 hours light breeze from S.S.W.
 Long. E. with fine weather the Bark steering by
 8.10 the wind on the Starboard tack &
 saw 3 porpoises one man sick off duty

Lat. S. Friday Nov-16th
 8.07 These 24 hours light breeze from S.W. with
 Long. E. fine weather the Bark steering by the wind
 8.45 on the Starboard tack and a plenty of
 Alpine Blackfish during the day
 one man sick

Lat. S. Saturday Nov-17th
 8.30 These 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
 Long. E. with fine weather the Bark steering by the
 9.22 wind on the Starboard tack under all
 sail one man in the Forecastle sick and
 off duty and one Boatswain Frank Almada

Lat. S. Sunday Nov-18th
 8.00 These 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
 Long. E. first part steering by the wind on the
 10.08 Starboard tack middle part steering E.S.E.
 saw 3 porpoises one man sick off duty
 at night took in the light sails and
 luffed to the wind for the night

Lat. S. Monday Nov-19th
 8.32 These 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
 Long. E. the Bark steering N.E. by N. during the
 10.32 day saw one Seal at 2 P.M. gained her the
 Bark's attention of New Bedford last volume
 at night luffed with mainpail aback

Lat. S. Tuesday Nov-20th
 8.11 This day light breeze and fine weather at
 Long. E. daylight saw the Boatswain to windward
 10.41 steering the Bark N.W. by E. all day at night
 luffed to the wind on the Port tack

Lat. S. Wednesday Nov-21st 1883
 7.16 These 24 hours light breeze and fine
 Long. E. weather the Bark steering N.W. by E. all day
 10.29 at sunset took in the light sails and
 luffed to the wind on the
 Starboard tack saw Blackfish during the day

Lat. S. Thursday Nov-22nd
 6.30 These 24 hours light breeze from S.W. with
 fine weather the Bark steering N.W. by E. all
 day at night luffed to the wind on
 the Port tack under short sail painted
 the Starboard Boat during the day

Lat. S. Friday Nov-23rd
 These 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
 the Bark steering by the wind on the
 Port tack at 2 P.M. saw a white whale
 off the bow beam run for it but saw
 nothing more at sunset took in sail
 for the night so ends

Lat. S. Saturday Nov-24th
 6.15 These 24 hours light breeze with fine
 Long. E. weather the Bark steering by the wind
 8.20 on the Port tack heading N.W. by S.
 painted the Starboard Boat during
 the day so ends

Lat. S. Sunday Nov-25th
 6.06 These 24 hours fresh breeze from S.W.
 Long. E. the Bark steering by the wind on the
 8.26 Port tack heading N.W. by N. saw 3 porpoises
 and saw a Bark on the Starboard
 tack heading Eastward
