

Friday Feb-22nd 1884

Lat- S. These 24 hours fresh breeze from S.E. 15.15 and cloudy weather the Bark steering by the wind on the Port tack until 3.53 the Flying jib and repaired it and bent it again during the day

Saturday Feb-23rd

Lat- S. These 24 hours fresh breeze from S.E. 16.15 and cloudy weather the Bark steering by Long E the wind on the Port tack until 2.41 compasses during the day

Sunday Feb-24th

Lat- S. These 24 hours fresh breeze and squally 17.10 wind from S.E. the Bark steering by Long E the wind on the Port tack until 2.41 sunset then put the Bark on the Starboard tack

Monday Feb-25th

Lat- S. These 24 hours fresh breeze and squally 16.50 weather with light showers of rain Long E wind from S.E. the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack Lat 5 P.M. saw a school of Blackfish hauled two Boats for them but get none came on board again 5.30

Tuesday Feb-26th

Lat- S. These 24 hours strong breeze and squally 16.05 weather wind from S.E. the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack 3.05 tack

Wednesday Feb-27th

Lat- S. These 24 hours fresh breeze from S.E. by S. 15.12 with fine weather the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack 3.43 repaired the Foresail during the day so ends

Thursday Feb-28th 1884

Lat- S. These 24 hours light breeze from S.E. 14.30 with fine weather the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack 4.35

Friday Feb-29th

These 24 hours light breeze from S.E. with fine weather the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack saw a Finback and Grampian

Saturday March 1st

These 24 hours light breeze from about S. with cloudy weather the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack

Sunday March 2nd

Lat- S. These 24 hours light breeze from about 14.10 with fine weather the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack Long E 7.24

Monday March 3rd

Lat- S. These 24 hours fresh breeze from S.E. 14.00 the weather fine the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack until 8.53 1.30 P.M. they went on the Port tack saw finbacks during the day and saw a white water to midward Bent a Ketchikan

Tuesday March 4th

Lat- S. The first part of these 24 hours 14.00 strong breeze from about S. with fine weather middle and latter part fresh breeze the Bark steering by the wind on the Starboard tack saw a White water and steered for it an hour but saw nothing more
