Friday March 7th
 Lat. S. 14.20 These 24 hours fresh breeze and fine
 Long. E. weather the Bark steering by the wind
 10.03 on the Port tack heading W. by S.

Saturday March 8th
 Lat. S. 14.42 These 24 hours light breeze and fine
 weather the Bark steering by the wind
 Long. E. on the Port tack saw a breach to
 8.58 windward in the morning made two
 tacks but saw nothing more saw
 a Finback at 4 P.M.

Sunday March 9th
 Lat. S. 15.17 These 24 hours fresh breeze from S. by W.
 with fine weather the Bark steering by
 Long. E. the wind on the Port tack saw 6
 7.42 Compressed and Periwinkles

Monday March 10th
 Lat. S. 15.46 These 24 hours fresh breeze from S.
 Long. E. with fine weather the Bark steering
 6.32 by the wind on the Port tack

Tuesday March 11th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours fresh breeze from S. and
 Long. E. squally the Bark steering by the wind
 on the Port tack

Wednesday March 12th 1884

 17.05 fine weather Wind from about South the
 Long. E. Bark steering by the wind on the Port tack
 4.49 at sunset reefed Topsails

Thursday March 13th

Friday March 14th
 These 24 hours light breeze and cloudy
 the Bark steering by the wind on the

Saturday March 15th
 Lat. S. 19.05 These 24 hours light breeze and fine
 Long. E. weather Wind from S. E. the Bark steering
 2.53 by the wind on the Port tack at
 sunset shortened sail

Sunday March 16th
 Lat. S. 19.40 These 24 hours light breeze and fine
 Long. E. weather Wind from S. E. the Bark steering
 2.03 W. during the day at sunset luffed to
 the wind on the Port tack and took
 in sail for the night

Monday March 17th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light breeze and some
 20.18 squally the Bark steering W. N. W. all
 Long. E. day & at night luffed to the wind on
 0.59 the Starboard tack under reefed Topsails
 wind from S. E. set up the foretop
 mast backstays and Topgallant backstays
 during the day
