

Friday May 2nd 1884
These 24 hours light breeze from
Southward the weather fine the Bark
steering by the wind on the Port
tack. Saw Sperm whales and a Bark
steering Westward

Saturday May 3rd
The first best fresh breeze from S.W. the
Bark steering by the wind on the Port
tack. Middle land better fresh light breeze
Weather fine saw the Island and saw
Sperm whales at sunset the Island bearing
N.W. by W. so ends fine

Sunday May 4th
These 24 hours light trade winds with
fine weather the Island bearing N.W. steered
the Bark for the Island all day saw a
Whaling Bark on the Eastern tack

Monday May 5th
These 24 hours light breeze and fine
weather about 8 A.M. sent a boat on
shore after the two Disasters but did not
get them sent the Boat on board again
stripped two seamen and got on board
at 5 P.M. and stood out at sea on the
Starboard tack so ends

Tuesday May 6th
This 24 hours light trade winds with
very fine weather the Bark steering by
the wind on the Starboard tack. Sailed
bearing E. sent in the Jib and the
watch employed in in repairing
it all day saw two Finbacks
The Island in sight all day

Wednesday May 7th 1884
Lat. S. 14.43 This 24 hours light breeze and fine
Long. W. 4.58 weather the Bark steering by the wind
on the Starboard tack. Finished repairing
the Jib and bent it again

Thursday 8th
Lat. S. 14.00 These 24 hours light air from S.E.
Long. W. 4.11 with fine weather the Bark steering
by the wind on the Starboard tack

Friday May 9th
Lat. S. 13.30 These 24 hours light breeze from
Long. W. 3.48 S.E. by S. the Bark steering by the wind
on the Starboard tack. Weather fine
saw Sperm whales and a Sulphur bottom

Saturday May 10th
Lat. S. 13.00 These 24 hours light breeze from S.E.
Long. W. 2.59 with fine weather the Bark steering
by the wind on the Starboard tack
saw saw Sperm whales

Sunday May 11th
Lat. S. 12.03 These 24 hours light breeze from S.E.
Long. W. 2.04 with fine weather the Bark steering
by the wind on the Starboard tack

Monday May 12th
Lat. S. 11.10 These 24 hours fresh S.E. trade winds
Long. W. 0.55 the Bark steering by the wind on
the Starboard tack saw Sperm whales
and Finbacks

Tuesday May 13th
Lat. S. 10.16 These 24 hours fresh S.E. winds the
Long. E. 0.05 Bark steering by the wind on the
Starboard tack saw a Finback
