Lat. S. These 24 houses fresh breeze from S. E.
 9. 57 and fine weather at 7.40. A. M. saw
 Long. E. a large Breach off the weather beam the
 1. 34 Bark being on the Starboard tack at
 8.45 went on the Port tack and saw
 it again 6 or 7 miles off at 11.30. went
 on the Starboard tack again saw nothing
 more of it

Thursday May 15th

Lat. S. These 24 houses light breeze from S. E.
 9. 08 with fine weather the Bark steering by
 Long. E. the wind on the Starboard tack the
 2. 17 watch employed in repairing an
 old Topsail

Friday May 16th

Lat. S. These 24 houses light breeze from S. E.
 8.45 with fine weather the Bark steering by
 Long. E. the wind on the Starboard tack the
 3.28 watch employed in repairing an
 old Topsail finished one and began
 on another

Saturday May 17th

Lat. S. These 24 houses fresh breeze from S. E.
 8.13 the Bark steering by the wind on the
 Long. E. Starboard tack finished repairing the Topsails
 3. 06 saw one Finback during the day

Sunday May 18th

Lat. S. These 24 houses fresh breeze from S. E.
 8. 00 the Bark steering by the wind on
 Long. E. the Starboard tack
 2. 38

Monday May 19th

Lat. S. The first part of these 24 houses strong breeze
 8. 05 from S. E. in the fore part fresh breeze latter
 Long. E. Part light breeze the Bark steering by
 2. 40 the wind on the Starboard tack saw a
 Finback during the day

Tuesday May 20th 1884

Lat. S. These 24 houses fresh breeze from S. S. W.
 8. 18 weather thick and smoky the Bark steering
 Long. E. by the wind on the Starboard tack
 8. 53

Wednesday May 21st

Lat. S. These 24 houses light breeze from S. E. E.
 8. 30 with fine weather the Bark steering by
 Long. E. the wind on the Starboard tack saw
 9. 55 a Finback during the day

Thursday May 22nd

Lat. S. These 24 houses light breeze from S. S. W.
 8. 32 the weather cloudy the Bark steering by the
 Long. E. wind on the Starboard tack saw a
 10. 34 large breach at 4.45 P. M. steered for it
 until sunset but saw nothing more

Friday May 23rd

Lat. S. These 24 houses light breeze and fine weather
 8. 38 at 2. A. M. put the Bark on the Port tack
 Long. E. saw Grampuses and went to the Topsails
 10. 23 and bent two old ones the Bark heading
 about West all day

Saturday May 24th

Lat. S. These 24 houses light breeze from S. S. W.
 8. 28 with fine weather the Bark steering by the
 Long. E. wind on the Port tack saw Finbacks
 9. 34 and Grampuses during the day

Sunday May 25th

These 24 houses fresh breeze from S. S. W.
 at 12 noon put the Bark on the Starboard
 tack and steered by the wind the
 weather fine so sails
