 9. 26 saw two Humpbacks

Sunday June 8th
 Lat. S. 8. 47 These 24 barrels light breeze from Southward
 Long. E. 10. 10 over unsteady the Bark steering Eastward
 weather fine saw Porpoises and Grampuses

Monday June 9th
 Lat. S. 8. 27 These 24 barrels light breeze from Southward
 Long. E. 11. 12 the weather fine the Bark steering by the
 wind on the Starboard tack held from
 E. to S.E. by E. saw Finbacks during the day

Tuesday June 10th
 Lat. S. 8. 10 These 24 barrels light breeze from S. Westward
 Long. E. 12. 05 during the night the Bark steering by the
 wind heading S.E. by E. at 6 A.M. raised
 a School of Sperm Whales at 7. lowered
 three Boats. Starboard Boat struck and then
 Weather Boat struck got the two Whales
 to the Ship at about 11 A.M. the Starboard
 Boat chased off after the school and struck
 but a humpback Whale passed the line and
 got on board at about 3 P.M. at 2.30 P.M.
 and finished at 6.20 P.M. and made sail
 saw a Whale going E.N.E. lowered the Starboard
 Boat for him but it was too late came on
 board at 6.15 P.M. so ended the L.B. E. W. slightly
 store

Wednesday June 11th
 Lat. S. 8. 07 This day light breeze and fine weather at
 Long. E. 12. 10 6 A.M. raised a School of Sperm Whales lowered
 three Boats. Starboard and Weather Boat struck
 the L. Boat line passed and lost the Whale
 got the Weather Boat Whale to the ship at
 1 P.M. cut him in and cut up some
 of the blubber at 2.30 P.M. began to Boil
 so ended

Thursday June 12th 1884
 Lat. S. 8. 20 These 24 barrels and and fine weather
 Long. E. 12. 14 the Bark steering by the wind all hands
 employed in boiling and clearing away
 the three Whales heads so ends Boiling
 saw finbacks during the day

Friday June 13th
 Lat. S. 8. 04 These 24 barrels light breeze and fine
 Long. E. 12. 01 weather the Bark steering by the wind
 saw Grampuses and Blackfish finished
 Boiling at 2.30 P.M. so ends

Saturday June 14th
 Lat. S. 8. 12 These 24 barrels light breeze from S.S.W. the
 Long. E. 12. 08 Bark steering by the wind weather fine
 saw Finback and a Humpback and
 two Merchant vessels the Watch employed
 in stowing down some of the Oil

Sunday June 15th
 Lat. S. 8. 16 These 24 barrels fine breeze from S.S.W.
 Long. E. 12. 56 with fine weather the Bark steering by
 the wind on the Port tack while
 sunset then put her on the Starboard
 tack saw a School of Killers during the day

Monday June 16th
 These 24 barrels light breeze from S.S.W.
 with cloudy weather the Bark steering
 by the wind on the Starboard tack
 finished stowing down the Oil
 stowed down in all 48 Barrels
 saw Blackfish and Finbacks and
 Porpoises during the day.
