

Friday July 4th 1884

These 24 hours fresh breeze and cloudy weather at 8.20 A.M. lowered the two Quarter Boats and cruised saw nothing. The Waite Boats crew on board boiling Boats got on board at 6.30 P.M.

Saturday July 5th

This day light breeze and cloudy at 8.30. A.M. lowered the two quarter Boats and cruised saw nothing. Waite Boats crew on board Boats finished boiling at 2 P.M. Boats got on board at 6.30 P.M. so ends

Sunday July 6th

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw 5 Whales but got none Boats got on board at sunset

Monday July 7th

This day light breeze and fine weather all hands on board stowing down the Oil stored down 2nd deck saw 3 Whales from the ship finished stowing down so ends this day

Tuesday July 8th

These 24 hours light breeze and cloudy at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw one Whale Starboard and Waite Boats got on board at 10 P.M. last sight of Starboard Boat at 6 P.M.

Wednesday July 9th

This day fresh breeze at 6.30. lowered Starboard and Waite Boats in search of Starboard Boat S.B. got to the ship at 3 P.M. saw Whales and went to chase and at 4.30. struck got the ship underway at tack the Whale alongside and made fast and anchored the ship at 10 P.M. all Boats on board

Thursday July 10th 1884

These 24 hours light air and calm with foggy weather at daylight got ready and began to cut in the Whale finished and lowered the two Starboard Boats and cruised for Humphreys saw two but got none Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M. so ends

Friday July 11th

These 24 hours light breeze and calm lowered all three Boats saw six Whales got none Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M. saw some ships Boats to seaward at 1.30 P.M. began to boil so ends Boiling

Saturday July 12th

These 24 hours light breeze and fine weather at 8 A.M. lowered the two Starboard Boats and cruised saw two Whales got none saw one from the ship Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M. finished boiling at 8 P.M.

Sunday July 13th

This day light calm and calm at daylight lowered all three Boats and cruised saw 5 Whales got none Boats got on board at 8 P.M.

Monday July 14th

These 24 hours light air and calm at daylight lowered the Starboard and Waite Boats Starboard Boats crew on board stowing down the Oil stored down 2nd deck Boats got on board at 6 P.M.

Tuesday July 15th

This day light breeze and calm and foggy at daylight lowered three Boats saw one Whale got none Boats got on board at 6 P.M. so ends
