

Wednesday July 16th 1884

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw 2 Whales about 8 A.M. Starboard Boat struck at 10.30 men drew out and lost the Whale spouting Board Boat got on board at 5.30 P.M.

Thursday July 17th

This day light air and calm at 5.30 A.M. hove up Anchor and let the Bark drift down the coast lowered three Boats and cruised saw 2 Whales but could not strike Boats got on board at 6 P.M. Anchored the Bark again so ends

Friday July 18th

These 24 hours light air and calm at daylight hove up Anchor lowered three Boats saw 5 Whales got none Boats got on board at 6 P.M. Anchored the Bark again in 18 fathoms of water so ends

Saturday July 19th

This day light breeze and cloudy at daylight hove up Anchor and steered the Bark down the coast lowered the three Boats saw one Whale got none the Bark Anchored at about 12 noon Boats got on board at 7.30 P.M. so ends lying at Anchor off Matita Point

Sunday July 20th

This day light air and calm weather cloudy at daylight lowered all three Boats and cruised saw 4 Whales but got none Boats got on board about 5 P.M. A Boat from shore came on board during the day

Monday July 21st 1884

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw 2 Whales got none Boats got on board at 6 P.M. so ends this day

Tuesday July 22nd

This day light breeze with fine weather at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw six or seven Whales but got none Boats got on board at 6 P.M.

Wednesday July 23rd

This day light breeze and calm with fine weather at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw two Whales at 3 P.M. Starboard Boat struck at 3.10 P.M. men drew out and lost the Whale Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M.

Thursday July 24th

These 24 hours light air and calm at daylight lowered three Boats saw nothing Boats got on board at 6 P.M.

Friday July 25th

This day light breeze and fine weather at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw two Whales but got none saw a Steamer steering Southward and saw a Whaling Bark she Anchored off about 1 mile distance at 7.30 P.M. Boats got on board at 6.30 P.M.

Saturday July 26th

This day light breeze and fine weather at daylight lowered three Boats saw nothing Capt King of Bark Merring Star came on board during the day Boats got on board at 7 P.M. so ends
