

Tuesday August 5th 1884

This day fresh breeze and cloudy lowered all three Boats and cruised saw 3 Whales and a Cow & Calf going to Northward and saw several Whales going Southward Boats got on board at 6.30 P.M. two men in forecabin sick and off duty

Wednesday August 6th

This day fresh breeze and cloudy at day light lowered the two quarter Boats and cruised saw three Whales began to boil at 8 A.M. and finished at 8 P.M. Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M. two men sick and off duty

Thursday August 7th

This day fresh breeze and cloudy at daylight lowered three Boats and cruised saw seven Whales one of them going Southward Boats got on board at 6.30 P.M.

Friday August 8th

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered the Starboard and Waist Boats Starboard Boats crew on board stowing down the Oil found down 50 lbs saw a plenty of Whales Boats got on board at 6 P.M. the two men that were sick returned to duty

Saturday August 9th

This day light air and calm at daylight lowered three Boats saw 8 Whales but got none Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M.

Sunday August 10th 1884

This day light breeze at 6 A.M. lowered three Boats saw three Whales got none Boats got on board at 6.30 P.M.

Monday August 11th

This day light breeze and cloudy at daylight lowered three Boats saw 4 Whales one of them to Westward at 2 P.M. Starboard Boat struck one at 3 P.M. Starboard Boat struck killed the Whales and got one of them to the Ship at 9 P.M. 9.30 sent the Boats to get the other Whales so ends

Tuesday August 12th

This day light breeze and fine weather got the Whale to the ship at 2 A.M. at 6 A.M. began to cut finished at 11 A.M. saw several Whales from the ship lowered two Boats for them one but did not get any came on board again so ends this day

Wednesday August 13th

This day light breeze and fine weather at daylight lowered three Boats saw 2 or 3 Whales got none Boats got on board at 7 P.M.

Thursday August 14th

This day light breeze at daylight lowered three Boats saw a plenty Whales got none Boats got on board at 4 P.M. broke out some Barks for Oil and at 5 P.M. began to boil so ends
