

Friday August 15th 1884

This day light breeze and fine weather at 6.30 A.M. lowered the two starboard Boats saw several Whales going Southward and two going Northward. Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M. finished boiling at 2 P.M.

Saturday August 16th

This day day light breeze and cloudy at daylight lowered three Boats saw 3 or 4 Whales going Southward. Boats got on board at 6.30 A.M. at daylight hove up Anchor and stowed the Back down. The Boat Anchored again about 4 P.M. off Maunabo Bay Nicholas Lawrence sick and off duty.

Sunday August 17th

This day fresh breeze and some showers of rain at 6.30 lowered three Boats saw two Whales going Southward. Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M. Nicholas Lawrence off duty.

Monday August 18th

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered the Starboard and Whistle Boat. Starboard Boat crew on board getting ready to stow Oil at 10.30. Boat went out shore and got a load of Wood and got on board at 12.30. about 11.30 A.M. Starboard Boat struck a Whale killed him and got him to the ship at 3 P.M. at 4 P.M. began cut finished at 8 P.M. Nicholas Lawrence still off duty.

Tuesday August 19th

This day light breeze and some fog all hands employed in cutting blubber Backing and stowing down Oil. Stowed down about 24 bbls saw two Whales going Northward. Nicholas Lawrence still off duty.

Wednesday August 20th 1884

This day fine breeze and weather fine at 7 A.M. lowered the two quarter Boats saw one Whale going Northward. Boats got on board at 6.30 finished boiling about noon. Nicholas Lawrence still off duty and one more man in forecabin. Name Penna —

Thursday August 21st

This day light breeze at daylight lowered three Boats saw one Whale going Northward. Boats got on board at 6 P.M. Nicholas Lawrence still off duty.

Friday August 22nd

This day fine weather all hands on board stowing Oil. Nicholas Lawrence still off duty.

Saturday August 23rd

This day light breeze and calm at daylight lowered the two quarter Boats saw nothing. Boats got on board at 6.30 P.M. finished stowing down the Oil stowed about 50 bbls. Nicholas Lawrence and Penna off duty sick.

Sunday August 24th

This day light breeze and pleasant weather about 7 A.M. lowered three Boats and cruised saw one Whale going Northward. Boats got on board at 5.30 P.M. Nicholas Lawrence and Penna still off duty.
