

Wednesday Sept 3rd 1886
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light breeze and
 3.30 fine weather Wind from S.W. the
 Long. E. Bark steering by the wind on the
 6.19 Port tack until 3 P.M. then put
 her on the Starboard tack saw
 several Blackfish during the day
 Nicholas Lawrence still off duty

Thursday Sept 4th
 Lat. S. This 24 hours light breeze and fine weather
 3.25 the Bark steering by the wind on the
 Long. E. Port tack heading West. Nicholas Lawrence
 5.50 still off duty

Friday Sept 5th
 Lat. S. This 24 hours light breeze and fine weather
 3.38 the Bark steering by the wind first put on
 Long. E. Port tack heading N.E. & S. latter part on
 4.33 the Starboard tack heading S.E. Nicholas
 Lawrence still off duty saw a plenty Blackfish
 during the day

Saturday Sept 6th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours fine breeze from about
 4.00 S.E. the Bark steering by the wind on
 Long. E. the Port tack saw a plenty of Cowfish
 4.19 and Taperies during the day. This day
 Nicholas Lawrence returned to duty
 and Penna off duty sick

Sunday Sept 7th
 Lat. S. This 24 hours light breeze from S.E.W.
 The Bark steering by the wind on the
 Long. E. Starboard tack saw Sperm whales during
 the day

Monday Sept 8th 1884
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
 4.21 with fine weather the Bark steering by
 Long. E. the wind on the Starboard tack
 4.58 saw a School of Blackfish during the
 day. Penna still off duty

Tuesday Sept 9th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours fresh breeze and cloudy
 4.40 with one or two light showers of rain
 Long. E. the Bark steering by the wind on the
 5.47 Starboard tack heading from S.E. & E. to
 S.W. & E. Penna still off duty

Wednesday Sept 10th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours fresh breeze and fine
 5.00 weather the Bark steering by the wind
 Long. E. on the Starboard tack heading about
 6.38 S.E. saw several Finbacks during the
 day Penna still off duty

Thursday Sept 11th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light breeze and
 5.13 cloudy the Bark steering by the
 wind on the Starboard tack heading
 about S.E. the most of the time
 Penna this returned to duty
 saw a School of Blackfish during the day

Friday Sept 12th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light breeze and
 5.30 calm the Bark steering by the wind
 Long. E. on the Starboard tack heading about
 5.44 S.E. when there was a breeze so ends

Saturday Sept 13th
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light air the weather
 5.52 fine the Bark steering by the wind
 Long. E. on the Starboard tack heading
 8.17 S.E. under all sail
