

Lat. S. Tuesday Sept. 23<sup>rd</sup> 1884  
 6.36 These 24 hours light breeze and  
 Long. E. fine weather the Bark steering by the  
 10.23 wind on the Port tack heading from  
 W. to W. N. W. saw Grampse

Lat. S. Wednesday Sept. 24  
 6.22 first part of these 24 hours light breeze and  
 Long. E. fine weather at 6.30 A.M. raised a school  
 9.33 of sperm Whales going to leeward at 7.30.  
 captured three Boats about 10 A.M.  
 Starboard Boat struck and the other  
 Boats struck soon after turned up the  
 three Whales and Starboard and Waite  
 Boats chased off the school and Starboard  
 Boat struck a large Whale got the Whale  
 sporting blood and got skinned and the  
 Boat rolled over and had to cut line  
 and lost the Whale Waite Boat picked  
 up the wreck and got to the ship  
 about 5 P.M. at about 7 P.M. got  
 the three Whales fast along side and  
 got supper so ends this day

Thursday Sept. 25<sup>th</sup>  
 These 24 hours fresh and light breeze  
 from S.W. with cloudy or drizzle  
 called all hands and got ready to cut  
 began to cut at 6.30 A.M. and finished  
 at 3 P.M. saw a plenty of Blackfish  
 during the day at night stood Boats  
 crew watches at night put the Boats  
 on the Port tack at 3.30 P.M. under Japson

W.P.  
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Friday Sept. 26<sup>th</sup> 1884  
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light breeze and calm  
 5.53 the Bark steering by the wind under all  
 sail at 7 A.M. began to boil saw  
 Blackfish and Grampse during the  
 day so ends Boiling

Saturday Sept. 27<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat. S. This day light breeze and fine weather  
 5.57 the Bark steering by the wind besting  
 Long. E. to windward saw Grampse during  
 9.49 the day so ends boiling

Sunday Sept. 28<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light air and calm  
 6.18 the Bark steering by the wind under  
 Long. E. all sail saw Blackfish and a plenty  
 9.57 of Grampse finished boiling at  
 1. A.M. got the Boat off the Haul  
 and put her on the Starboard Bow  
 covered so much Whole turned up 67 lbs

Monday Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light breeze and calm  
 6.17 the Bark steering by the wind on  
 Long. E. different tack which very unsteady from  
 9.29 W. S. W. to S. S. W. saw several Grampse  
 and Grampse and Blackfish several

Tuesday Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat. S. These 24 hours light air and calm  
 6.24 with some light showers of rain in the  
 Long. E. morning the Bark steering by the wind  
 9.57 most of the day on the Port tack  
 heading W. N. W. saw Grampse  
 during the day wind very unsteady  
 the Bark making to S. S. W. all  
 possible so ends this day

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
