June the 18 the Day of the Month - Friday
At 7 pm took in Sail Double reef Topsails
& Laid with St Balm & hand Lark and Penple
Ceplexitay of mind too think that we are so far
from our home In this remote part of the World
where every person of admiration is secluded
from our view and while I set sitting with my
side of me it make me feel Disagreeable to look
so far ahead from the Time to come Not one de-
sirable have I had from home since I left my
these hours On the morning of the 19 the
Moderate gales from the South with thick hazy
weather At 8 am saw a breach off the Starboard
bow In about 1 1/2 hours saw several finbacks of
nothing more seen the hole Day brook out
The after hoal and got up 8 baskes of bread
Started them into small baskes that we had
Setting up because we wanted the largest
Finished about 12 and then Satted a barrel of
fish which makes us 8 1/2 barrels too made with
spatives of the Sandwich Islanders for fruit
Sun set took in the Topsails and laid by
The night On the morning of the 20 Saturday
Strong winds from the S.W. with thick and
Lay weather at 10 am continued thick but the
Wind Dide Sun & the brook out the
hoal for more bread got up 2 bask of bread
and started them and stode them again

And got up 1 bask of Shuks and then stowed
off again nothing seen from the Mast head the
Day But 1 old fin back that was so old that
he could not get out of this latitude He
stook it surge for to pass away those dull
hours the at 4 pm heepled down in the
hoal and got down shooks head for the
That just waked me up so having no more
to write this time The time In contented
I The 21 of June Sunday nothing going on
On board this Day 3 hand aloft looking out
Whale But nothing seen Light winds from
S.W. we sail close haul at 2 pm the
Wind Dide in again in a couple of
At sunset Double reef the topsails and
Laid along about 8 1/2 with a tolerable stiff
breeze from the S.W. and at 9 pm the
Wind continued to breeze & quite hazy but few
shore But howsoever on the morning of the
22 July only saw whales of the lee and
bow and we heard and the second main
stuck a large whale and then mister
And then the main All the boat fast
