

Our whale parted our new line and short
Work and then we went and help kill one
of them and got them along side 25 min
With before 9 am but one body in and cut off
both heads out off the whale that mister
Brought alongside we got our ions out of
him so we don't know how he belongs too
I went too Boyling the body strong
from the S W and flights of rain and then
Barge continued so all night on the morning
of the 23 Tuesday finished putting about 4 P.M. and
then we cut up the leads finks so bad & and
we drive the works at 10 o'clock & 10 minutes later
over 30 lbs. Drudeout & continued good weather
last day and I hope we shall get some oil
This will make over 100 lbs of oil good
The 24 the Wednesday fine weather all the day
& nothing seen from the Mast Lead 2
hands aloft the greater part of the time
at 7 pm had all the body Trade out and
went on the lead at 11 in the morning

June 1829
Of the 22 finished and washed off Thursday
Strong winds from S W and considerable sea
At 9 am Coopered all the oil and the brook out
then shook and in the afternoon set down of
Wp & At Sun set took in sail and laid by the
thing seen from the mast head this day but
Squid and that is a good line for them most
Unrais whales On the morning of the 26 Dr
Friday the Atmosphere was overcast with
Heavy clouds & looked as though we were going
to have some snow weather but the clouds cleared about
10 o'clock and we had good weather all day the W
Wind was about S E W and blew a gentle breeze
Gave many pieces off squid seen too day but
nothing seen from off that looked like a
Whale at 7 pm got things in readiness for
stowing down the oil and then took in sail &
laid by the night On the 27
board Jack our Mait has cut his foot with a
sawd Vamp bad cut sum off the sinews
off & he limps upon it crutched and
