him And found him Hangside and made him fast
For the night and set the watch On the morning of
The 8 Wednesday cut our whale In about 5 pm
And then began too Boil Wind about 10 fine
Weather and smooth
On the morning of the 9th Thursday fine Weather
About 6 am finished Boiling the head And
began of the Boddy & handed off to Look for

And about 8 am saw Whales ahead and him

Both round us and about 1/2 past 10 Landed the whale
the boat and Landed Boats and put for the

And landed on too him And And set And In it
Short Time had him Dead Took him along side
And he got our Dinner & then began too cut
At 5 pm had his head cut off and then Lashed
The Piece Down too the Main Shire and then we
Dropped a few back & set the watch fine We
then the Wind about 10 with a grate swell
Which makes it bad at cutting plenty of Whales
All around us but Haggard shy and ugly had
the Boats cracked several Tines and a few hurt
On the morning of the 10 Friday About Sun
Rise hooked on too the Piece And cut away and by
Breakfast Time had the Boddy Cuttin Got aboard
Fast & and began on the head & by 1/2 past 11
had the case back & the rest of the Lashed Wee an
Setting up Pipes for Between decks the Lashed
