about 7 AM saw a large Whale Under our
Lee Quarter it spouting he did not seem to
bee killed and hee came right Under our fore
Breen Windows and then he said in a few min
its he went down and when he came up
there was several Lung Whale with him

about Disk clocked off and got supper the wind
about S.W. and a strong breeze and largey but
a little sea on the morning of the 13 fine W. W.

noon at 12 pm there was 1 Cask too wee got
our Dinner and loaded the boats and in a
few minutes 1 came up right at head off us
