About 12 M and then it cleared and it was fine
Weather all the remainder part off the Day nothing
seen but Blackfish at 3 pm set the boat off
Dark took in sail and laid by for night.
On the 31st first continued foul weather till 10
boat 10 then cleared nothing seen from the
about this Day all hands employed in Shibolet &
city at 4 pm made the comment and went out
out 2 shot 8 shot Wind about 10 M & light
On the 1st of August saw 10 whales land and
struck the captain's parent and got lost and then
the second mate and then the main found them 24
The Capt. got stove at sun set got them along side
troubled them and then took in sail and set the
watch fine weather wind about 8 M saw 10
The night before about 1 pm under the bows 30 night
When the ship drifted struck them on the back
and they started to the windward only on the 2nd
Day got ready for action and by 4 pm had all
in and began to sail fine weather wind about
10 and light saw nothing this Day from the
Deck all hands left for too back out 33
Only on the 3rd Day Monday saw 10 whales 20
them till 1 pm then found and the 1st mate
struck and parted the line and saw one 10
2 ships to the windward then came on
board and got dinner and found again

Then the mate faceded 1000 was fast too him
1000 sun set 10 then got and came on board the
ship recovery got 1 and took him along side
This Day the second mate fell over board out
off the boat he did not know how to swim 10
see and the after barsman jumped after him
and he got lost off us and liked too drowned us
both but then let the sheet go 10 and too 10
got him in too the boat I was so far gone that
when they got me in I fell in the bottom off
the boat and could not get up for some time
I was so weak the 2 ships was the Venus off
and the 10 convicts of London fine weather
about 10 and light on the 4th fine weather
continued sailing at 10 pm saw 10 backs and
thought they were 1000 10 4 pm 10
sailing found 10 10 10 10 10 10 10 10 10 10
went on board of the Venus Coffin too tea
and stand till 9 pm and then came on board
took in sail and set the watch wind about 10
On the 5th Day fine weather all Day nothing
seen from the boat but porpoises & skipjacks
I cooked the oil and got it ready for too
star down in about 10 and light 10
off dark kept topsails and set the watch
Only on the 6th Day began to star down
oil at 9 am saw 10 ships too the
