William & Eliza Nothing else seen this day at 4 PM
The wind breezed and became squally At Sun
set in the afternoon and Pump Ship out to end
The transactions of this day Latitude 45° 50' Long.
On the 28th Strong Winds from the SW which being
and drove our sail and side 11 AM & After breakfast
broke out and stood that down by 4 PM and
then passed off saw 2 ships to the windward &
supposed them to be the same Nothing else seen
This day I expect that all the Whales to struck
off Ocean to come here so ends this day Latitude
The same Longitude 103° 22' On the 29th Strong Wind blew
he out and stood broad and at 11 AM finished
and then went to find Whaling saw 2 ships one
was the Sir Charles Price and the William & Eliza
having clearland & hand aloft Nothing seen
So end this day Latitude 45° 15' Longitude 103° 40'
On the 30th the Strong Trades saw our comrades off
our weather beam At 10 AM 1 of them was out of
sight all hands Employed in ships duty at 11 AM
saw a spot to the west saw it 4 times and saw it
more at 4 PM saw 2 ships off the lee beam
but did not know them At Sun set
Tacked and stood to the other coast so ends
The transactions of this day Latitude 51° 10' South

On the 31st Just Strong Winds saw a ship off the
Weather beam about 7 AM she run down too
It was the horse off New Bedford 6 months out
Capt Baudouin he had the Skirva in his breast and
wanted a position He went on board and
got breakfast then got a plenty of Tobacco
Mass bound light in to Cathita at about 1 PM
Raid Whales Landed and got 100 lbs of blubber
and took him along side about 4 PM and
took in sail and got snug by being set 3 ships
to the leeward so ends this days Latitude
51° 30' On the 1st Day of February fine weather began
To set out in the Cape and Cape by 2 PM
At 4 PM saw a ship off the weather beam
and supposed her to be the same Nothing else seen
At 11 AM saw a ship to the windward & supposed
her to be the same Nothing else seen
At 4 PM saw 2 ships off the weather beam
but did not know them At Sun set
Tacked and stood to the other coast so ends
The transactions of this day Latitude 51° 30' South
