On the 8th strong winds from the N.E. and cloudy weather
At 7 am hauled down the head sails and made 9th
Lawn the fore topgansail and fore topsail & set 9th the
topmast riggin and backstays and then made sail again
At 10 am hauled up the main topsail and went in
went Another 2 men went to work on the riggin At 5 pm
hoisted off So ends this Day Latitude 12° 8' 3" South
On the 9 fine weather but strong trades carrying all sail
At 4 am started to cast off water in the but and
then got breakfast and camped in the riggin and then
had till sunset and then hoisted off So ends this Days
Drift. Latitude 14° 12' By Accurate observation &c
On the 10th fine weather and strong trades all hands
Employed setting the riggin 2 hands. Hoist clothing seen
At 4 pm saw 2 man-of-war sails & tropic birds sails
This Day Latitude 16° 30' South Long 107° 12' 00"

On the 11 strong winds and very squally made down
the topsails several times in the course of Day lying
through sudden squalls but all hands Employed
in fitting blocks stops most all fitted & hauled at
4 pm set the fore & main topgansail and at
5 set the Mizzen So ends this Day with strong Gale
Latitude this Day Moon 18° 57' South Long 107° 30'

On the 12 strong winds from the N.E. and
squalls off rain 1 Watch below and rest Employed
in the Afternoon all hands Upon Deck
fitting the riggin worked till sunset and
then hoisted off So ends this Day. Work &
Latitude 20° 21'
