The 24 hours commenced with gentle gales and fair weather at 2 pm spoke the ship off new Bedford cap. Luce 11 months out with 400 lbs off right whale oil the cap came on board he was bound right home at 12 saw another sail so ends the 24 hours Latitude 13° 46' South Longitude 26° 13'

The 24 hours commenced with gentle gales and cloudy weather at 1 pm broke the main top gallant yard off in the S. E. sent that down at 4 pm sent that up again at 7 pm set the rigging all the middle part gentle gales all the latter moderate so ends the 24 hours Latitude 11° 43'

The 24 hours begins with gentle gales from the N. E. and smooth sea all hands Employed in snapping yards & chain bolts run hands buckling the anchor &c all the middle part gentle breezes and cloudy weather at 5 am saw and spoke the Georg & Martha off new Bedford cap. Abner Gills from the banks the 1700 lbs of oil cap went on board so ends the 24 hours Latitude 9° 27'

The 24 hours commenced with gentle breezes and fair weather all hands Employed in the duty at 10 pm cap Cooks came on board and spent the day so ends the 24 hours Latitude 8° 44' Longitude 34° 11'
