Lat by Obs 17° 20' N Long 132° 05' W

Remarks on board Tuesday May 4<sup>th</sup> 1847

These 24 hours Commences with a fine breeze from the Northward and pleasant weather heading WNW under all sail Middle part light wind from the N and pleasant Latter part the same heading WNW under all sail hands employed in ships duty saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours  
Lat 18° 14' N Long 134° 50' W

Remarks on board Wednesday May 5<sup>th</sup> 1847

These 24 hours Commences with a fine breeze from the Northward and pleasant weather heading WNW Middle and Latter part light breeze from the NE and pleasant steering W by E set the Fore Top mast studding sail hands employed in ships duty saw Nothing So Ends  
Lat by Obs 18° 39' N Long 135° 45' W

These 24 hours Commences with light breeze from the NE and pleasant weather steering W by N Middle and Latter part the same steering W by E under all sail hands employed in Tarring down the Rigging, saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours  
Lat by Obs 20° 04' N Long by Chron 140° 00' W  
Long by Lunar 139° 15' W Diff 45 miles

Remarks on board Saturday May 8<sup>th</sup> 1847

These 24 hours Commences with light Trades from the NE and pleasant weather steering W by N under all sail, Middle and Latter part the same hands employed in ships duty saw Nothing So Ends  
Lat by Obs 20° 30' N Long by Chron 142° 21' W  
Long by Lunar 141° 45' W Diff 36 miles

Remarks on board Sunday May 9<sup>th</sup> 1847

These 24 hours Commences with fine Trade wind from the NE and pleasant steering W by N under all sail Middle and Latter part fine Trades and pleasant steering W by S under all sail saw Nothing So Ends  
Lat by Obs 20° 46' N Long by Chron 144° 50' W  
Long by Lunar 144° 00' W

Remarks on board Monday May 10<sup>th</sup> 1847

These 24 hours Commences with fine Trades from the NE and pleasant weather steering W by S under all sail Middle part fine Trades with some rain Latter part fine Trades and pleasant steering W by S under all sail hands employed in ships duty saw Nothing So Ends  
Lat by Obs 20° 51' N Long by Chron 147° 08' W
