Remarks on board Sunday June 20th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate wind from the S and pleasant weather heading W by N at under all sail at sun set shortened sail. Middle and Latter part light breeze from the S and pleasant heading W by N at 6 P M made all sail saw nothing So Ends

Lat by Obs 30° 04' N Long 169° 04' E

Remarks on board Monday June 21st 1847

These 24 hours Commences with light breeze from the S and pleasant weather heading to the Westward under all sail. Middle and Latter part the same. bent the Fore and Main Top sails. Main Top gallant sail and Fore sail for Cruising sails saw nothing So Ends

Lat by Obs 29° 58' N Long 168° 06' East

Remarks on board Tuesday June 22d 1847

These 24 hours Commences with light breeze from the S and pleasant weather heading to the Westward under all sail. Middle part light air from the S and pleasant Latter part Cabin employed in repairing the old Mizzen Top sail for a Cruising sail saw nothing So Ends

Lat by Obs 29° 52' N Long 167° 23' East

Remarks on board Wednesday June 23d 1847

These 24 hours Commences with light air from the S and pleasant weather heading to the Westward. bent and set Mizzen Top sail for a Cruising sail. Middle and Latter part light air from the Eastward and pleasant steering SW under all sail. saw Porpoises broke out for water So Ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Friday June 25th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with a fine breeze from the Eastward and pleasant weather Middle and Latter part the same working to the Westward under all sail. hands employed in ships duty saw nothing So Ends

Lat by Obs 29° 43' N Long 163° 43' East

Remarks on board Saturday June 26th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with light breeze from the SE and pleasant weather steering N by E at 4 P M hauled on the Wind heading E by E Middle and Latter part light breeze from the Eastward and pleasant heading to the Northward. saw a Finback and Porpoises So Ends

Lat by Obs 30° 27' N Long 163° 41' East

Remarks on board Sunday June 27th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with light breeze from the E and pleasant weather heading to the Northward under all sail. Middle part heading to the Northward under short sail Latter part light light breeze from the S heading to the E under all sail saw Fin backs So Ends these 24 hours
