Remarks on board Monday July 12th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light breeze from the S
 and pleasant weather Middle and Latter part
 light breeze from the Northward and pleasant
 at 10 o'clock finished boiling, repairing the Larboard
 boat ship Martha and ship John in sight
 So Ends Lat 31° 34' N Long

Remarks on board Tuesday July 13th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light breeze from the N
 and pleasant weather Middle part light breeze
 from the NE and pleasant Latter part the same
 heading on Differant Tacks, repairing the L boat
 one ship in sight So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat 30° 20' N Long 169° 00' E

Remarks on board Wednesday July 14th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light breeze from the NE
 and pleasant weather Middle and Latter part the same
 heading to the N and Westward, employed in ship duty
 saw a Finback 3 ships in sight So Ends
 Lat by Obs 31° 22' N Long 168° 22' East

Remarks on board Thursday July 15th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light wind from the NE
 and pleasant, Middle and Latter part light breeze from
 the Eastward, standing on differant Tacks, Repaired
 the old boat, Coal Tard the Anchors &c saw 2 ships
 So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat by Obs 31° 58' N Long 168° 28' East

Remarks on board Friday July 16th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light breeze from the E and
 pleasant weather, at 8 o'clock spoke the ship John of New
 Bedford Capt Sanford 37 months out 1500 blb
 of sperm oil Middle and Latter part light breeze
 from the S and pleasant standing on Differant Tacks
 saw Porpoise hands employed in ships duty So Ends
 Lat by Obs 31° 56' N Long 168° 2

Remarks on board Saturday July 17th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light breeze from the S
 and pleasant weather Middle and Latter part the same
 heading on Differant Tacks one ship in sight So Ends
 Lat 31° 56' N

Remarks on board Sunday July 18th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light breeze from the S
 and pleasant weather, Middle part the same Latter
 part light breeze from the S and pleasant at 6 o'clock
 saw sperm whales Landed the boats and shared
 with out success whales very wild So Ends in
 Chasing, Lat 32° 06' N Long 169° 10' E

Remarks on board Monday July 19th 1847
 There 24 hours Com with light breeze from the S
 and pleasant at 2 o'clock boats came on board after
 a long chase Middle and Latter part light breeze
 from the Eastward and pleasant saw Finbacks
 hands employed in ships duty So Ends
 Lat by Obs 31° 59' N Long 169° 53' East
