These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the S and pleasant. Middle and Latter part the same standing on Differant Tacks saw Nothing So Ends
Lat by Obs 30° 34' N Long 171° 02' East

Remarks on board Tuesday August 3^d 1847
These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the S and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze and squally from the S standing on Differant Tacks saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours.

Remarks on board Wednesday August 4th.
These 24 hours Com with fresh breeze from the S with some rain. Middle part squally. Latter part light breeze from the S and pleasant saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 31° 15' N Long 171° 41' E

Remarks on board Thursday Aug 5th 1847
These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the SW and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter part squally from the S under short sail saw Nothing So Ends. Lat 31° 11' N Long 171° 15'

Remarks on board Friday August 6th
These 24 hours Com with light wind from the S and cloudy. Middle and Latter part squally from the S ship under short sail saw Nothing So Ends
Lat by Obs 31° 12' N Long 171° 09' E

These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the SW and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter part the same heading on Differant Tacks saw Nothing So Ends
Lat by Obs 31° 05' N Long 171° 11' East

Remarks on board Sunday August 8th
These 24 Com with light breeze from the W and pleasant. Middle part calm, Latter part light breeze from the NW and pleasant heading to the S and Westward saw Nothing So Ends
Lat by Obs 30° 35' N

Remarks on board Monday August 9th
These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the NW and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter part light breeze from the N and pleasant heading on Differant Tacks hands employed in ships duty 2 ships in sight. So Ends
Lat by Obs 30° 42' N Long 171° 10' E

Remarks on board Tuesday August 10th
These 24 hours Com with fresh breeze from the Northward and pleasant weather at 5 P.M. spoke the ship Leonides of New Bedford 21 months out 700 Bbl of sperm oil. Middle and Latter part fresh gale from the Eastward under short sail heading on Differant Tacks So Ends
