part fine breeze from the Eastward and pleasant
employed in Steping in new Canvas in the Main
Top sail saw nothing So Ends these 24 hours

These 24 hours Com with Moderate wind and pleasant
weather from the Eastward, Middle and Latter the same
standing on Differant Tacks saw nothing So Ends

from the Eastward and Cloudy saw nothing So Ends

Remarks on board Monday August 16th
These 24 hours Com with fresh breeze from the E
and cloudy Middle part the same. Latter part
fine breeze from the E and pleasant at 11 o'clock spoke
the Ship Ann Alexander of New Bedford 21 months
out 570 Bbls of sperm oil. Ship Martha of New
Bedford in sight. So Ends Caught 6 or 7 Bbls of
Fish Lat 31° 02' N Long 170° 30' East

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug 17th 1847
These 24 hours Com with fine breeze from the E
and pleasant Ship Ann Alexander in company
Middle and Latter part fine breeze from the E
and pleasant stand on Differant Tacks 3
ships in sight So Ends

Lat by Obs 30° 54' N Long 170° 54' East

Remarks on board Wednesday Aug 18th
These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the ESE
and pleasant Middle and Latter part fine breeze
from the NE and pleasant at 11 o'clock saw spots
of our weather bow Lowered the boats for them
proved to be Fin backs So Ends with pleasant
weather
