Remarks on board Thursday Aug 19th

These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the N E and pleasant weather Middle part the same Latter part fresh breeze from E S E and pleasant heading on Different Tacks saw Fin backs, employed in Steping in their Canvas in the Fore Top sail So Ends Lat by Obs 31.41 N Long 170.40 E

Remarks on board Friday Aug 20th 1847

These 24 hours Com with fresh breeze from the Eastward and pleasant Middle part squally with rain Latter part fresh breeze from the Eastward and pleasant standing on Different Tacks saw Fin backs one ship in sight So Ends

Lat by Obs 31.10 N Long

Remarks on board Saturday Aug 21st

These 24 hours Com with a fine breeze from the Eastward and pleasant Middle and Latter part strong breeze from the E with some rain stand on Different Tacks saw Fin backs one ship in sight So Ends

Lat by Obs 31.26 N Long 170.48 East

Remarks on board Sunday Aug 22^d

These 24 hours Com with a strong breeze from the Eastward at 5 P M spoke the ship Lalla Rookh of New Bedford 33 months out 1400 Bbls of sper and 200 Whale Middle and Latter part strong breeze from the E heading to the Southward under short sail Fin back So Ends

Lat 30.32 N Long

Remarks on board Monday Aug 23^d 1847

These 24 hours Com with fresh breeze from the East Middle part the same heading to the Southward under double reef Top sails Latter part more moderate made all sail saw Fin backs one ship in sight So Ends Lat by Obs 30.52 N

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug 24th 1847

These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the East and pleasant weather heading to the S and Eastward Middle and Latter part fine breeze from the Northward and pleasant heading to the Eastward saw Fin backs one ship in sight So Ends

Lat by Obs 30.18 N Long 172.18 E

Remarks on board ~~Wednesday~~ Friday Aug 25th 1847

These 24 hours Com with a fine breeze from the Northward and pleasant weather Middle and Latter part light air from the N and pleasant hands employed in ships duty one ship in sight So Ends Lat by Obs 30.31 Long 173.10 East

Remarks on board Thursday Aug 26th 1847

These 24 hours Com with light air from the North and pleasant weather heading to the Eastward under all sail at sun set shortened sail Middle part light breeze from the N Latter part the same at day light made all sail heading to the Eastward hands employed in ships duty one sail in sight So Ends Lat by Obs 30.33 N Long
