Remarks on board Monday Sept 6th 1847
These 24 hours Com with fresh breeze from the NE
and cloudy weather at 2 P.M. doubled reef the Top
sails Middle part squally under short sail, Latter
part Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant
heading to the S and Eastward under all sail, Painted
the Fore mast and the Eyes of the Lower Rigging
saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 30° 18' N Long 178° 48' E

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 7th
These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the E
and pleasant weather heading to the S under all
sail at 2 P.M. tacked to the Northward Middle
and Latter part light breeze and variable and
pleasant weather brok out for some Iron hoops,
saw Nothing So Ends Lat 30° 52' N Long 179° 46'

These 24 hours ^{Com} with light breeze from the South
and pleasant weather steering to the Northward
Middle and Latter part the same hands employe
in ships duty saw Fin backs So Ends

Turned the Cape Horn in the Forecastle for Repeated Anchors

Remarks on board Friday Sept 10th
These 24 hours Com with light breeze from
the Eastward and pleasant, at 4 P.M.
spoke the Ship Lalla Rookh of New Bedford
Capt Keynard 33 months out 1100 Bbls 200 H
Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from the East
and pleasant heading to the Southward saw Nothing
So Ends Lat by Obs 31° 16' N Long 179° 50'
