saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Friday Sept 17th 1847

These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the Eastward
and pleasant Middle and Latter part the, at 10 o'clock
spoke the Ship Leonides of New Bedford 22 months
out 750 Bbls of sperm oil and gammed saw
Fin backs and grampuses So Ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 18th
These 24 hours Com with light breeze from the
Eastward and pleasant weather Middle and
Latter part calm and pleasant, in company
com with the ship Leonides So Ends

Lat 32° 06' N Long 179° 02' West

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 19th
These 24 hours Com with light airs from the
Westward and pleasant Middle part calm
Latter part squally from the Northward under
single reef top sail heading to the Eastward
Ship Leonides in sight So Ends

Lat 32° 03' N Long 178° 30' West

Remarks on board Monday Sept 20th
These 24 hours Com with fresh breeze from the
N E and squally Middle part squally close
reef the top sails heading to the S and Eastward Latter
part Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant
heading to the S under all sail saw Nothing So Ends
