weigh and Lay off and on until 5 P.M. when
the Captain came on board with one more
Man making in all Eleven Shipped Here, Twelve
Discharged and one run away. Middle and Latter
part Light wind and Variables steering to the Westward
for Woahoo at 7 P.M. saw Woahoo bearing WNW
Dist 35 miles 2 ships in sight
