Remarks on board Saturday, Nov 13th
Then 24 hours Commences with Moderate wind
from the Eastward and Cloudy weather heading
to the Southward Middle and Latter part
Squally from the N and Eastward heading
to the S and Eastward under double reef Top
sails saw Nothing So Ends then 24 hours
Lat 15° 03' N

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 14th
Then 24 hours Commences with Squally weather
from the N and Eastward Middle and Latter
part strong wind from the Eastward heading to
the Southward under double reef Top sails saw
Nothing So Ends Lat 13° 53' N Long 156° 37' W

Remarks on board Monday Nov 15th 1847
These 24 hours Commences with Strong wind from the
Eastward and Cloudy Middle and Latter part Strong
from the S and pleasant heading to the Southward
under double reef Top sails saw Nothing So Ends
Lat 12° 38' N Long 156° 15' West

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 16th 1847
Then 24 hours Commences with strong wind from
the Eastward and pleasant weather, Middle and
Latter part squally from the Eastward heading
to the Southward under short sail, Hands
employed in Ships Duty Saw Nothing So Ends

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 17th 1847
Then 24 hours Commences with squally weather
from the Eastward heading to the Southward under
short sail Middle and Latter part light squalls
from the Eastward heading to the S under all
sail Saw Nothing So Ends then 24 hours
Lat by Obs 10° 24' N

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 18th
Then 24 hours Commences with fresh breeze
from the Eastward and squally weather Middle and
Latter part Squally heading to the Southward under
short sail Saw Nothing So Ends then 24 hours
Lat 8° 41' N Long 154° 23' West

Remarks on board Friday Nov 19th 1847
Then 24 hours Commences with fresh squalls from
the Eastward Middle and Latter part the same
with heavy rain heading to the S and Eastward
under short sail Saw Nothing So Ends

Remarks on board Saturday Nov 20th
Then 24 hours Commences with squally weather
from the Eastward Middle and Latter part the
same heading to the Southward under short
sail Saw Nothing So Ends with rainy
weather Lat 6° 40' N
