Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 22^d 1847

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant standing on Different Tacks under the Lee of Marys Island at 4 P.M. the Captain went ashore with boats crew at sunset returned Middle and Latter part Light breeze and pleasant on Different Tacks the Island in sight saw Nothing Hands employed in ships Duty, James Jones & Coony again So Ends

Lat by Obs 8th 02 S Long 174th 46 West

Remarks on board Thursday Dec 23^d 1846

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant standing on Different Tacks Marys Island in sight Middle part light breeze heaving to the S and Eastward at 3 P.M. hauled aback the Main Yard at Day Light kept off S & E at 6 P.M. saw Birnie's ^{Island} bearing S by W Dist 10 miles at 7 P.M. saw something that looked like and old wreck but too rugged to go and see So Ends steering S by W 1/2 W

Lat by Obs 04th 05 S Long 171th 48 W

Remarks on board Friday Dec 24th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant steering S by W 1/2 W at 4 P.M. saw Sydney's Island bearing S by W Middle part on Different Tacks to the weather of the Island Latter part Light breeze and pleasant at Daylight kept off for the Island 2 Boats went afishing about 1 hour caught Nothing So Ends steering W by W Lat by Obs 04th 20 Long

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 25th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant steering W by W at 3 P.M. Put Hand Cuffs on James Jones for Abuse to the Captain Middle part pleasant steering to the N and Eastward under short sail Latter part pleasant at 8 P.M. took the Hand Cuffs of from James Jones Promising He would do better, at 9 P.M. saw Muthers Island bearing W by W Dist 10 miles at 11 P.M. tried for some time under the Lee of the I at 12 M. Boat came on board with out success saw Nothing So Ends steering W by W

Remarks on board Sunday Dec 26th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant ^{N by W} Middle and Latter part the same steering W by W saw Nothing So Ends

Lat by Obs 02th 02

Remarks on board Monday Dec 27th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant steering N by W Middle and Latter part the same saw funpers, Hands employed in ships Duty one sail in sight So Ends

Lat by Obs 02th 23 miles S Long 175th 44 West

Remarks on board Tuesday Dec 28th 1847

These 24 hours Commences with fresh breeze from the Eastward and pleasant Middle and Latter part the same heading on Different Tacks at 11 P.M. saw New Kentucket Island, one ship in sight So Ends

Lat by Obs 00th 11 miles North Long 176th 44 West
