Remarks on board Thursday Jan 27th 1848

These 24 hours commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward and rainy weather in company with the Ship United States Middle and latter part pleasant heaving to the Westward 3 Ships in sight So Ends these 24 hours

Lat by Obs 00.50 miles South Long 170

Remarks on board Friday Jan 28th 1848

~~These~~ 24 hours commences with ~~moderate~~ breeze from the Eastward and pleasant steering N by S in company with the Ship United States, and Ship Samuel Rob of Fairhaven and Ship Flor of Fair Haven, all steering for Ocean Island. Middle part pleasant Laying with the main yard aback. Latter part Light breeze and pleasant at Day Light saw Ocean Island bearing West Dist 12 miles, William Lenard and Robert Marley, Shiped January 13th have both Proved Bad men Marley Proving and Imposter Let them go at Ocean Island, Lenard Proving a Mutinous Character Deserted at the same Island, the Day before he Deserted Punished them for Mutinous Threats 4 Ships in sight So Ends heaving to the Northward

Remarks on board Saturday Jan 29th 1848

These 24 hours commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward steering to the N and Westward in company with the Ship United States Middle part pleasant steering West Latter part pleasant at 3 o'clock spoke the Bark Garland of New Bedford 24 months out 700 Bbls one other Ship in sight So Ends these 24 hours

Lat by Obs 00.41 miles S Long 168.10 E

Remarks on board Sunday Jan 30th

These 24 hours commences with Moderate breeze from the Eastward steering N by W, 5 Ships in sight, at 10 o'clock Luffed to heaving to the Northward with the main yard aback at Day light keep off N by S, at 10 o'clock saw Pleasant Island So Ends steering for the Island

Lat by Obs 00.20 miles S Long 167.00 East

Remarks on board Monday Jan 31st

These 24 hours commences with Moderate breeze and variables steering for the Island at ^{2.30} the Canoes came off to us Traded for 2 Hogs and 2 dozen Fowl Middle and latter part the same standing on different Tacks at 10 o'clock the Canoes came off to us again from Pleasant Island Traded for 2 or 3 Dozen Fowl and a Barrel of Molasses James Jones Traded So Ends Lat by Obs 00 34 miles S Long 166.50 East
