Remarks on board Friday April 7<sup>th</sup> 1848

These 24 hours commences with light breeze from the Westward and pleasant steering NNE, Middle and latter part strong wind from NW heading to the N and Eastward under snug sail Ship Splendid and Bark Newton in company So Ends Lat by Obs 30° 23' N Long

Remarks on board Saturday April 8<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours commences with strong wind from the Northward and hazy weather heading ENE under short sail. Middle part heading same Westward latter part moderate heading to the Northward employed in Ships Duty Ship Splendid and Bark Newton in company So Ends Lat 30° 55' N Long 127° 33'

Remarks on board Sunday April 9<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours commences with moderate breeze from the Northward and Eastward. Middle part squally from the Northward doubled reefed the Top sails and furled the Main sail. Latter part blowing heavy from the N Laying too under a close reef Main Top sail Ship Splendid and Bark Newton in company So Ends Lat

Remarks on board Monday April 10<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours commences with a fresh gale from the Northward and Cloudy Laying too under storm sails heading to the Eastward Middle and latter part Laying too heading to the Westward Ship Splendid and Bark Newton in company So Ends Lat 31° 05' N Long 127° 10' East

Remarks on board Tuesday April 11<sup>th</sup> 1848

These 24 hours commences with a fresh gale from the NE and Cloudy weather Laying too under close reef Main Top sail and Storm Stay sails Middle part more moderate wind from the Eastward heading to the Northward under double reef Top sails latter part fresh breeze from the Southward steering NE by N Ship Splendid and Bark Newton in company So Ends

Lat by Obs 31° 42' N Long 126° 40' East

Remarks on board Wednesday April 12<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours commences with a fresh breeze from the Southward and rainy weather steering NE at 4 PM wind from the Westward at 6 PM doubled reef the Top sails and furled the Main sail. Latter part fresh gale from the Northward heading to the Eastward under close reef Top sails Ship Splendid and Bark Newton in company So Ends

Lat by DR 32° 13' N Long by DR 127° 45' E

Remarks on board Thursday April 13<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours commences with a fresh gale from the Northward heading to the Eastward under close reef Top sails at 5 PM saw the After Car bearing SE by E Dist 14 miles at 7 PM wind from the NE heading NNE at 12 M fresh gale from the Northward heading to the Westward Latter part the same Ship Splendid and Bark Newton in company one Ship in sight So Ends these 24 hours

Lat by Obs 32° 33' N Long 127° 15' East
