Remarks on board Wednesday May 31st 1848
 Then 24 hours Commences with a calm and pleasant
 weather employed in Scraping Bone, at 9 P.M. began
 to boil. Middle and Latter part Light wind and Variables
 saw a dead whale Badly blasted, 3 Ships in sight
 So Ends in boiling
 Lat by Obs 41.42 N

Remarks on board Thursday May June 1st
 Then 24 hours Commences with Light breeze from the
 Northward and pleasant Clear and calm with occ
 Lucys, Middle part Light breeze and pleasant, Latter
 part fresh breeze from the Southward and foggy
 weather employed in boiling So Ends

Remarks on board Friday June 2nd
 Then 24 hours Commences with a fresh breeze
 from the Southward and foggy weather, Middle
 and Latter part the same at 10 P.M. finished boiling
 So Ends in Scraping Bone
 Lat 41.46 N

Remarks on board Saturday June 3rd
 Then 24 hours Commences with a fine breeze
 from the Southward and pleasant weather
 at 4 P.M. Lowerd for whales got one to the
 Starboard boat, Middle and Latter part fresh
 breeze, and rainy weather employed in Cutting
 in So Ends No Observation

Remarks on board Sunday June 4th
 Then 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze
 from the Southward and rainy weather

in the Japan Sea, in June 1848
 Middle part the same, Latter part Moderate with
 fog, at 6 P.M. began to boil, So Ends
 Lat

Remarks on board Monday June 5th
 Then 24 hours Commences with moderate breeze
 from the Southward and foggy weather
 employed in boiling and Stowing down
 Middle part foggy Latter part fresh gale from
 the Northward Stowed down 92 Bbls of
 Whale oil in the Fore Hold So Ends
 Lat Long

Remarks on board Tuesday June 6th
 Then 24 hours Commences with a fresh gale
 from the Northward, Middle part Moderate
 Latter part Light breeze from the Southward
 employed in boiling saw Nothing So Ends
 Lat by Obs 41.25 N

Remarks on board Wednesday June 7th
 Then 24 hours Commences with Light breeze
 from the Southward and pleasant weather
 Middle and Latter part rainy finished boiling
 Saw Nothing So Ends

Remarks on board Thursday June 8th
 Then 24 hours Commences with Moderate breeze
 from the Southward, Middle and Latter part fresh
 breeze from the Westward, employed in Ship's Duty
 Saw Nothing So Ends
 Lat by Obs 41.48 N Long 136.51 East
