Remarks on board Sunday July 30th
Then 24 hours Commences with a calm and pleasant
weather, Middle and Latter part light breeze
from the NE with some fog saw four ships
So Ends Lat 42° 54' N

Remarks on board Monday July 31st
Then 24 hours light wind and variable with foggy
weather steering to the Northward and Eastward
saw nothing So Ends

Lat 43° 20' N Long 136° 55' East

Remarks on board Tuesday August 1st
Then 24 hours light breeze from the Southward
and pleasant weather steering NE and NE E
at 9 o'clock spoke the Ship Champion of
New Bedford Captain Parker 12 months
out 800 Bbls of oil So Ends in Gambling
Lat by Obs 44° 34' N

Remarks on board Wednesday August 2^d
Then 24 hours Light breeze from the SE and
pleasant weather in company with the Ship
Champion Captain Parker Let us have
20 Bbls of Fresh Water So Ends steering
to the N and Eastward in company with the C
Lat by Obs 45° 10' N Long 138° 43' E

Remarks on board Thursday August 3^d
Then 24 hours Light breeze from the Southward and
pleasant steering to the Eastward at 5 o'clock saw
the Langale Island bearing E by S Dist 40 miles
four ships in sight, all steering for the Ochotsk
Sea So Ends

Lat by Obs 45° 25'

in the Ochotsk Sea in August 1848

Remarks on board Friday August 4th
Then 24 hours light breeze from the Southward and
pleasant weather steering to the Eastward, came
through the Straits of ~~the~~ in the night
saw some lights on shore, saw whales and
Chased with our guns. So Ends
four ships in sight
Lat 45° 38' N Light Long

Remarks on board Saturday August 5th
Then 24 hours Moderate breeze from the Southward
and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. saw right whales
Lowered the boats, got Two whales, at 6 P.M. got
them both a long side at Daylight began to
cut in, spoke the Ship Berditch of Warren
14 whales this season, So Ends
Lat by Obs 45° 38' N Long 143° 41' East

Remark on board Sunday August 6th
Then 24 hours Commences with a fresh breeze from
the SE and pleasant employed in cutting in
at 3 P.M. finished cutting at 5 P.M. began
to boil, Middle and Latter part Light breeze
and variable employed in boiling saw the SE
End of Sagalin Island bearing NW Dist 20 miles
one ship in sight So Ends
Lat by Obs 45° 26' N

Remarks on board Monday August 7th
Then 24 hours light air and variable with some
fog employed in boiling saw Finbacks
So Ends there 24 hours
Lat 45° 17' N Long 144° 11' East
