Remarks on board Tuesday August 8th
Then 24 hours light breeze from the S and Eastward
with some fog employed in boiling, saw Finbacks
So Ends Lat 45.37 N Long

Remarks on board Wednesday August 9th
Then 24 hours moderate breeze from the S E and
foggy weather steering to the Northward employed
in boiling, at 6 AM finished boiling, began
to brake out for stowing down oil in the
Fore Peak So Ends

Remarks on board Thursday August 10th
Then 24 hours moderate breeze from the S E and
foggy weather, steering to the Northward employed
in stowing down oil in the Fore peak So Ends
Lat by Obs 47.03 Long

Remarks on board Friday August 11th
Then 24 hours moderate breezes and variables with
some fog saw Finbacks, employed in stowing
the bone in the Run, Saw the Porpoise Lagoon
bearing West Dist 25 miles So Ends

Remarks on board Saturday Aug 12th
Then 24 hours commences with a strong breeze
from the N E, with rain Middle part the same
Latter part moderate breeze from the Northward
and pleasant, one Ship in sight saw
Finbacks So Ends

Lat 47.10 N Long 145.40 East

in the Ochotsk Sea, in August 1848

Remarks on board Sunday August 13th
Then 24 hours commences with a moderate breeze
from the Northward and pleasant, spoke
the Ship Bark Pantheon. Full River 8 whales
this season, let her have two Pipes of Bread
we got two Casks of Water from her Middle
part Light breeze from the Southward steering
to the Northward Latter part fresh breeze
from the Southward, Chased Whales with
out Success Spoke the Ship Bengal of
New London Four Whales this season So Ends
Lat by Obs 47.34 N

Remarks on board Monday Aug 14th
Then 24 hours moderate breeze from the Southward and
pleasant Chased Whales with out Success one
Ship in sight So Ends
Lat by Obs 48.10 N

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug 15th
Then 24 hours commences with a moderate breeze from
the Southward and pleasant Chased Whales with out
Success, Middle and Latter part moderate breeze
from the Eastward steering to the Northward, one
Ship in sight So Ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Wednesday Aug 16th
Then 24 hours commences with a moderate breeze from
the Eastward with some rain, got a whale, at 10 AM
set to the Starboard Boat, at 11 AM set to the Whale
along side, at 5 AM began to quit at 11 AM finished
Cunning So Ends
