Remarks on board Thursday Sept 14th 1848
 Then 24 hours Commences with a Moderate breeze from the Eastward and pleasant weather heading to the Northward bent a new Fore sail Middle and Latter part Moderate and Cloudy weather heading to the N^W and Eastward employed in Ships Duty saw Nothing So Ends
 Lat 45° 18' N Long 155° 36' East

Remarks on board Friday Sept 15th
 Then 24 hours Commences with a Moderate breeze from the Eastward and Thick weather heading to the Northward at 4 P.M. Tacked to the N^W Middle and Latter part the same saw Nothing So Ends Lat 44° 04' N Long 156° 43' E

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 16th
 Then 24 hours Commences with a fresh breeze from the Eastward with rainy weather, at 2 P.M. Tacked to the Northward Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from ESE under double reef Top sails heading N^W saw Nothing So Ends with rain

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 17th
 Then 24 hours Commences with a fresh gale from ESE with rain, under double reef Top sails heading N^W Middle and Latter part fresh gale from the N^W and Thick weather, heading ESE under short sail, saw Nothing So Ends
 Lat 46° 08' N Long 159° 10' East

Remarks on board Monday Sept 18th
 Then 24 hours Commences with a fresh breeze from the ESE and Thick weather Middle part the same Latter part Moderate breeze from the Southward and foggy weather steering E by N under all sail saw Nothing So Ends
 Lat 46° 45' N Long 159° 50' East

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 19th
 Then 24 hours Commences with a Moderate breeze from the N^W and Cloudy weather steering E by N at 4 P.M. set the Fore Top mast Studding sail, at 6 P.M. wind from the Westward set the Lower Studding sail Middle and Latter part the same saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat 47° 16' N Long 161° 59' East

Remarks on board Wednesday Sept 20th
 Then 24 hours Commences with a fresh breeze from the Westward and Cloudy weather steering East at 4 P.M. took in the Lower Studding sail, at 5 P.M. took in the Top mast Studding sail Middle part squally from the Westward steering East, Latter part moderate breeze from N^W and pleasant steering East at 9 P.M. set Top mast and Lower Studding sails employed in Scraping bone
 Saw Nothing So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat by Obs 47° 20' N Long by Chron 165° 38'
 Long by Lunar 165° 56' East
