Monday Nov 21st 1848

First part there 24 hours strong winds and squally from the E N E
steering S E by S middle and latter parts strong winds from the East
steering S E under 2 reef topsails mainsail and lib so ends
employed in ship duty lat by Ob 16:57 long by Chron

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 22nd 1848

First part there 24 hours strong winds and squally from the
East middle and latter parts strong winds and squally
with rain from the E N E under 2 reef topsails mainsail
and lib steering S E by S so ends employed in ship duty
lat by Ob 13:08 long by Chron

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 23rd 1848

there 24 hours commences with strong winds and squally with
rain from the East heading S E middle part the same latter
part strong winds and pleasant from the E N E steering
S E by S at 9 A M let the reef out of the main topsail
so ends employed in ship duty
lat by Ob 11:41 long by Chron 159:58

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 24th 1848

First part there 24 hours strong winds and pleasant from the
E N E steering S E by S at 2 P M let the main topsail middle
and latter parts the same at 5 A M let the reef out of the
fore topsail at 9 A M when taken in the Waist boat very black
the crane gave away from when her lowered the starboard boat
and brought her along side and took her on deck finding
her stove so very bad the Captain had her knock up being
the old boat she was not fit to repair so ends
employed in ship duty

Remarks on board Saturday Nov 25th 1848

First part there 24 hours strong winds and pleasant from the
E N E steering S E by S middle and latter parts strong winds
and squally with rain steering S E so ends employed in
ship duty to things of duty with the fox
lat by Ob 08:05 long by Chron 158:35

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 26th 1848

First part there 24 hours strong winds and squally from
the E N E steering S E middle and latter parts strong winds
and heavy squally from the S E heading on the wind at 9 P M
put 2 reefs in the topsails at 3 A M took in mainsail and lib
so ends lat by S R 07:01 long by G. R. 158:47
one man off duty

Remarks on Board Ship Mechanic

Monday Nov 27th 1848

First part there 24 hours strong winds with heavy squalls middle part
more moderate from the E S E heading on the wind to the south at
3 A M let mainsail and lib latter part light winds and pleasant
made all sail so ends employed in ship one man of duty
lat by Ob 06:36 long by Chron 158:38

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 28th 1848

First part there 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather from the
East steering south middle and latter parts the same so ends
employed in ship duty one man of duty
lat by Ob 05:16 long by Chron 158:30

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 29th 1848

First part there 24 hours light wind and pleasant weather from
the East steering S E middle part squally at sun set took in
topgallantsails at 2 P M huff to the main yard so back
heading to the North at day light reef of S by S and made
all sail latter part pleasant so ends employed in ship duty
one man of duty lat by Ob 04:19 long by Chron 159:14

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 30th 1848

there 24 commences with fine pleasant weather at 2 P M saw
Parris Island Baring S by S 20 miles at sun set took in the
topgallantail and wore ship of shore at 2 A M took ship and stood
in and made all sail at 9 A M the captain went on shore and
brought 2000 ^{cocoa} nuts middle and latter parts pleasant so ends
at noon having off and on one man of duty
lat by Ob 03:49 long by Chron 159:22

Remarks on board Friday Dec 1st 1848

there 24 hours commences with pleasant weather having off and
on at Parris Island at 5 P M the captain came on board
and kept the ship by the wind to the south middle and
latter parts pleasant wind from the E S E so ends
employed in ship duty one man of duty
lat by Ob 03:04 long by Chron 159:45

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 2nd 1848

there 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather from the
E S E steering S E employed in ship duty so ends
one man of duty
lat by Ob 01:15 long by Chron 158:45
