There 24 hours light wind and pleasant weather from the E & E steering S by N at 7 P.M. Heaved to at 5 + 50 kept her S by E with all sail set to end one man of duty

First part there 24 hours light winds and pleasant steering S by N at 2 P.M. saw, seven whales going very fast to the East heaved but did not see them out of the boat's snout and latter part pleasant steering S by N to End employed in ship duty one man of duty

First part there 24 hours fine pleasant weather from the E & E steering S by N middle and latter part pleasant steering S by N to End employed in ship duty one man of duty

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 6th 1868

First part there 24 hours light winds and pleasant from the E & E steering S by N middle and latter part the same steering S by E saw Northmen to End employed in ship duty Domingo of duty

Remarks on board Thursday Dec 7th 1868

There 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light winds from the North steering S by E with all sail set to End employed in ship duty one man of duty

Remarks on board Friday Dec 8th 1868

There 24 hours fine pleasant weather from the N & E steering S by E with all sail set to End employed in ship duty Domingo returned to duty

First part there 24 hours light wind and pleasant from the N & E middle and latter part squally with rain from the E & E steering South to End employed in ship duty

First part there 24 light winds and pleasant from the South steering E & E middle and latter part winds from the North and equally with rain heading South with all sail set to End

Remarks on board Monday Dec 11th 1868

There 24 hours light winds and equally from the N & E steering S by E with all sail set employed mending sails to End James Duke of duty with the J.B.
Lat 4 06 10-45 Long 105-18

Remarks on board Tuesday Dec 12th 1868

There 24 hours light winds and pleasant from the E & E steering S by E with all sail set to End one man of duty employed in mending sails at 11 P.M. saw Mitchell Island bearing S by E 14 miles Lat 04 11-30 Long 105-30

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 13th 1868

There 24 hours light winds and pleasant from the S & E at 7 P.M. took ship to the E & E at 8 P.M. took ship heading S by N Mitchell Island in sight to End employed in ship duty one man of duty
Lat 04 11-43 Long 105-28

Remarks on board Thursday Dec 14th 1868

There 24 hours light winds and pleasant from the S & E heading S by E with all sail set employed in ship duty James Duke of duty

Remarks on board Friday Dec 15th 1868

There 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather from the East steering S by E at 10 P.M. saw the Starboard fore and aft and bent the old sails to End one man of duty

First part there 24 light wind and fine the S & E heading S by N middle part the same latter part winds from the East steering S by E employed in ship duty to End one man of duty
