N E heading 2 1/2 to 3 knots employed in ship duty

first part there 24 hours light winds from the N E
heading 2 1/2 to 4 P M kept off 1/2 of 1/2 mile and
latter part light air saw Black fish do Ench employed
in ship duty Lat 46 00 29 south long 3 40 17 1/2 East

Remarks Thursday June 28th 1849
there 24 hours light winds from East and pleasant
weather steering 1/2 of 1/2 to Ench employed in ship duty
Lat 46 11 12 south long 3 40 17 53 East

Remarks Friday June 29th 1849
there 24 hours light air from the East steering
1/2 of 1/2 to Ench saw 1 ship steering to the Eastward
employed in ship duty Lat 46 09 09 long 3 40 17

Remarks Saturday June 30th 1849
first part light air from the East steering 1/2 of 1/2 at 20 M saw
several high Island having 1/2 of 1/2 mile at 8 P M spoke the
ship Union of Fair Haven Capt Hathaway 26 mowth out 350 from 300 whale
at 9 A M buff too the wind with the main yard aback latter part
fresh wind from the E or E heading 2 1/2 to 3 knots ship Union
and Ocean Island in sight employed in ship duty
Lat 46 05 05 south long 3 40 17 00

Remarks Sunday July 1st 1849
there 24 hours fresh wind from the East heading
N E at 2 A M took ship to the S E to Ench
ship Union in sight Lat 46 00 45 south long 3 40 18 40

Remarks Monday July 2nd 1849
there 24 hours fresh wind from the East at 2 A M
steered 1/2 of 1/2 at 4 M set 1/2 of 1/2 too with the main
yard aback at 5 A M kept off 1/2 of 1/2 to Ench
employed in ship duty Lat 46 00 32 south long 3 40 18 15 East

Remarks Tuesday July 3rd 1849
first part steering 1/2 of 1/2 at 4 M set 1/2 of 1/2 too with the main
yard aback at 5 A M kept off 1/2 of 1/2 to Ench
pleasant Island having 2 1/2 miles saw ashore steering
to the West do Ench with fresh winds and pleasant weather
Lat 46 00 11 south long 3 40 18 06 East

there 24 hours moderate winds from the East and pleasant
weather heading on Jefferson took ship Union and Pleasant Island in
sight do Ench employed in ship duty
Lat 46 00 21 south long 3 40 18 42 East

Remarks Thursday July 5th 1849
there 24 hours moderate winds and pleasant weather
from the E or E heading on Jefferson took do Ench ship
Albion and Pleasant Island in sight employed in ship duty
Lat 46 00 04 south long 3 40 18 20

Remarks Friday July 5th 1849
first part moderate winds from the West heading E or E
middle part the same latter part calm do Ench
Lat 46 00 32 south long 3 40 18 40

Remarks Saturday July 7th 1849
first part calm middle part light winds from East
heading N E latter the same this day got 40 lb of
water 2 1/2 man by the name of Johnson for 15 lbs of
bread do Ench with pleasant weather laying off and on at Pleasant Island
Lat 46 02 21 south long 3 40 18 00

Remarks Sunday July 8th 1849
there 24 hours moderate winds from the East heading N E
do Ench saw fin backs and Black fish
Lat 46 00 53 south long 3 40 18 10

Remarks Monday July 9th 1849
first part light air from the East heading S E middle
part calm latter light winds from N E heading N E
do Ench saw nothing Lat 46 00 40 south long 3 40 18 38

Remarks Tuesday July 10th 1849
first light air heading N E middle part calm latter
light air from the E or E steering 1/2 of 1/2 saw nothing
employed in ship duty Lat 46 00 03 south long 3 40 18 50

Remarks Wednesday July 11th 1849
first part light winds from E or E steering 1/2 to 3 miles
latter steering 1/2 of 1/2 latter part wind from the E or E heading
1/2 of 1/2 do Ench saw nothing Lat 46 00 28 south long 3 40 19 00

Remarks Thursday July 12th 1849
there 24 hours moderate winds from the E or E heading
south do Ench with pleasant weather saw nothing
Lat 46 01 01 south long 3 40 18 50 East
