there 24 hours moderate winds from the East heading
S E & to End with pleasant weather saw nothing
lat 46 02 19 north long 158 30 00 June 10 5 59

Remarks Monday Sept 10th 1849

there 24 hours moderate winds from the East heading
S E & to End with pleasant weather saw nothing
lat 46 01 21 north long 158 20 00 June 10 5 52

Remarks Tuesday Sept 11th 1849

first part 24 hours heading S E middle part the same
latter part heading S E & winds from the East to End
saw nothing lat 46 01 00 north long 158 10 00 June 10 5 50

Remarks Wednesday Sept 12th 1849

there 24 hours fresh winds from S E & heading S E to End
with squally weather saw nothing
lat 46 02 02 north long 158 05 00 East

Remarks Thursday Sept 13th 1849

there 24 hours fresh winds from the East first part
heading S E & at 4 P M took ship heading S E latter
part the same to End saw nothing lat 46 01 35 north long 157 50 00

Remarks Friday Sept 14th 1849

there 24 hours strong winds from the East heading
S E & to End with pleasant weather saw nothing
lat 46 00 39 north long 157 40 00 East

Remarks Saturday Sept 15th 1849

there 24 hours moderate winds and pleasant weather from
East heading S E to End saw nothing
lat 46 00 39 north long 157 30 00 East

Remarks Sunday Sept 16th 1849

there 24 hours moderate winds from the East heading S E
to End with pleasant weather saw nothing
lat 46 01 20 north long 157 20 00 East

there 24 hours moderate winds from the East first part heading
S E & at 11 P M took ship to S E & to End with pleasant weather
saw nothing lat 46 02 20 north long 157 10 00

Remarks Tuesday Sept 18th 1849

first part 24 hours light air from the East heading S E &
middle and latter part calms to End saw nothing
lat 46 01 43 north long 156 50 00 East

Remarks Wednesday Sept 19th 1849

there 24 hours moderate winds from S E & heading S E
to End with pleasant weather saw nothing
lat 46 02 34 north long 156 40 00 East

Remarks Thursday Sept 20th 1849

this day strong winds from S E & heading S E to End with
squally weather saw nothing lat 46 03 44 north long 156 30 00 East

Remarks Friday Sept 21th 1849

this day strong winds from East heading S E at 10 P M saw
Horn Whales & weather became so bad the Boat could not
get near them to End the Whales going to the surface
lat 46 04 43 long 156 10 00 East

Remarks Saturday Sept 22th 1849

there 24 hours strong wind and squally from S E heading on
different tacks at 2 P M the boat returned on Board with getting
near them to End with rain lat 46 04 13 long 156 00 00

Remarks Sunday Sept 23th 1849

there 24 hours strong wind and squally from the East heading on
different tacks to End saw nothing lat 46 04 02 north long 155 50 00 East

Remarks Monday Sept 24th 1849

there 24 hours strong winds from East heading S E & saw nothing
to End with squally weather lat 46 04 58 north long 155 40 00 East

Remarks Tuesday Sept 25th 1849

there 24 hours moderate winds from E & E and pleasant weather
heading S E to End saw nothing employed in fishing
lat 46 05 54 north long 155 20 00 East

Remarks Wednesday Sept 26th 1849

first part winds from S E & heading S E middle part calms latter
part winds from North heading East calms with squally weather
lat 46 06 20 north long 155 10 00 East
