to End with all sail set employed in Ship duty

this day moderate winds from East steering North
no working employed in Ship duty
Lat 46 15.25 South long of Green 107 40 West

Remarks Friday April 12th 1850

this day commences with wind from East steering N by W middle
part calm latter part moderate winds from South
and pleasant weather steering N by W with all sail set
to End employed in Ship duty
Lat 46 14.12 South long of Green 107 00

Remarks Saturday April 13th 1850

this day moderate winds from S E steering N by W saw nothing
employed in Ship duty to End with all sail set
Lat 46 12.41 South long of Green 106 38 West

Remarks Sunday April 14th 1850

this day moderate winds and pleasant weather from the
East steering N by W to End saw nothing
Lat 46 11.07 long of Green 106 15 West

Remarks Monday April 15th 1850

First part this day moderate winds and pleasant from
East steering N by W middle part the same latter part
calm and rainy to End employed in Ship duty
Lat 46 09.58 South long of Green 106 10 West

Remarks Tuesday April 16th 1850

First part this day calm middle part moderate
winds from N E heading N by W latter part
the same to End saw nothing employed in
Ship duty
Lat 46 06.23 South long of Green 106 30

Wednesday April 17th 1850

First part this day moderate winds from N E heading
N by W middle part calm latter part moderate winds
from N E heading N by W to End employed in repairing
old sail saw nothing
Lat 46 07.35 South long of Green 106 10 West

Remarks Thursday April 18th 1850

this day moderate winds from N E heading N by W
to End saw nothing employed in repairing old sails
Lat 46 06.33 South long of Green 105 40 West

Remarks Friday April 19th 1850

this day moderate winds from N E heading
N by W to End saw nothing employed in Ship duty
Lat 46 05.15 South long of Green 105 20 West

Remarks Saturday April 20th 1850

this day moderate winds from N E heading N by W
to End saw nothing employed in repairing
old sails Lat 46 04.03 South long of Green

Remarks Sunday April 21st 1850

this day moderate winds from East steering
N by W at 2 P.M. saw seven whales going very
fast to the East about three hours without business
at 5 P.M. saw whales the barbed got fast and
the iron drew so that whales in sight
Lat 46 03.19 South long of Green

Remarks Monday April 22nd 1850

this day moderate winds from East at 3 P.M. the
barbed got fast and got very badly stuck to land
to repair the worst boat. like will get stuck there
the iron and barbed got fast to the same whale
and saved her at 5 P.M. however cutting at 9
to finish cutting and commenced cutting
to End employed in repairing fast boat and barbed
